1. Introduction

Publication of Education Statistics 2015/2016 is a joint publication of the cooperation between the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology (MEST) and the Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS). The data source for pre-university education is the Education Management Information System (EMIS). Data on education statistics for Serbian community that were not under the EMIS scope, with the exception of the municipality of Kamenica, are collected through questionnaires for education statistics by level. The northern part has not reported data for education statistics, although there has been a continuous effort by KAS to collect these data.

Data for public university education are provided by the Central Administration of the University of Pristina, Prizren, Peja, Gjakova, Gjilan and Mitrovica, while data for private colleges are provided by Kosovo Accreditation Agency. Publication of Education Statistics 2015/2016 can be found at MEST website: <http://masht.rks-gov.net/> and KAS website: <http://ask.rks-gov.net/>.

Description

Publication of Education Statistics 2015/2016 contains data about:

- the number of children in preschool and pre-primary education by gender, ethnicity, age and educational personnel,
- the number of pupils in primary and lower secondary education by gender, ethnicity, grade and educational personnel,
- the number of pupils in upper secondary education by gender, nationality, by vocational schools – gymnasiums and educational personnel,
- the number of pupils in special education by gender, grade and by types of impairment – difficulty,
- the number of students in university education by gender, ethnicity, faculties and programs of study, according to Bachelor and Master level, the number of Bachelor and Master's graduates and academic staff, etc.

Education data cover public and private sector, with the exception of some Serbian schools which have not reported data.

Definitions

Preschool Education

The level of preschool / pre-primary education presents the level 01 and 02 by adapting the definitions of the ISCED (International Standard Classification of Education).

Level 01: Presents the early development and education of children from 0 to 3 years of age.
Level 02: Pre-primary education, age 4 to 6 years.

Compulsory Education

Compulsory education presents the levels one and two by ISCED (International Standard Classification of Education). Primary education is classified as level 1 (grades 1-5) and level 2 is lower secondary education (grades 6-9).

Compulsory education in the country-level functions in public and non-public schools (licensed).

The level of primary education

Primary level lasts 5 years, starting from the first grade to fifth grade (1-5). At this level are enrolled children who turn 6 years of age. The age group of pupils at this level is from 6 to 10 years of age.

The level of lower secondary education

Lower secondary level extends from grade six to grade nine (6-9). The age group of pupils at this level is from 11 to 14 years of age, not counting those who repeat the grade and pupils with special needs.

The level of upper secondary education

Upper secondary education represents a level three (3) according to the ISCED (International Standard Classification of Education) and functions in public and private schools (licensed).

Based on the goals and content these schools are organized in gymnasiums and vocational schools.

Upper secondary schools (gymnasiums and vocational schools) are profiled schools. Gymnasiums are divided according to the directions on: social, general, science, mathematics-informatics and languages.

Vocational schools are also divided according to the directions on: technical, agricultural, economic, medicine, music, trade, theology, art and centres of competence.

Higher education (university) level (5 and 6) according to the ISCED (International Standard Classification of Education), is organized as follows:

The first level - three (3) to four (4) years of studies in which the student reaches 180, respectively 240 credits / ECTS and receives Bachelor degree,

The second level - one (1) to two (2) years of study after the completion of the first level in which student reaches 60 or 120 credits / ECTS and receives Master degree.

The third level - doctoral study programs with academic character and independent scientific research.

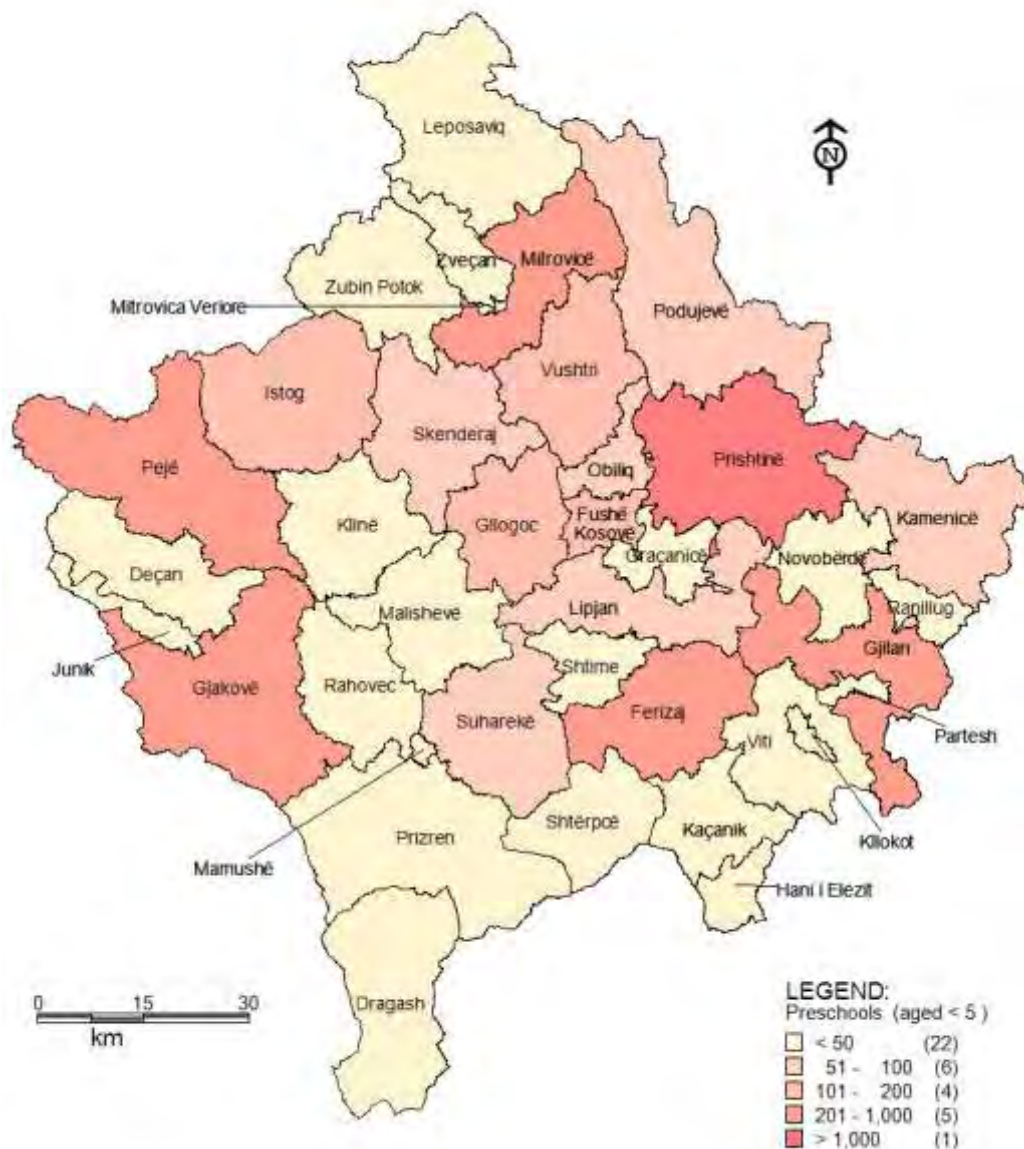
Higher education can be followed on a regular basis, and by correspondence. In charge of higher education may be public providers (universities established by the Government) and private providers of higher education (private colleges) licensed by the MEST.

Methodology

Data collection for pre-university education is done through Education Management Information System (EMIS) with the exception of some Serbian schools where Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS) has collected data through questionnaires.

Data for public higher education are collected by Kosovo Agency of Statistics from the Central Administration of the University of Pristina, Prizren, Peja, Gjakova, Gjilan and Mitrovica, while the data for private university education are collected with the cooperation of KAS with Kosovo Accreditation Agency.

NUMBER OF CHILDREN IN PRESCHOOL EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY 2015/2016



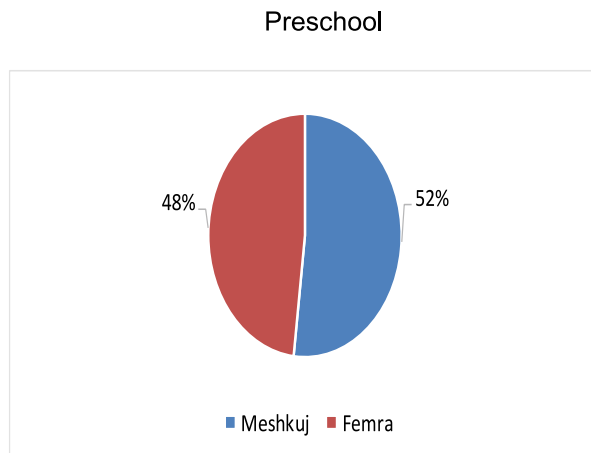

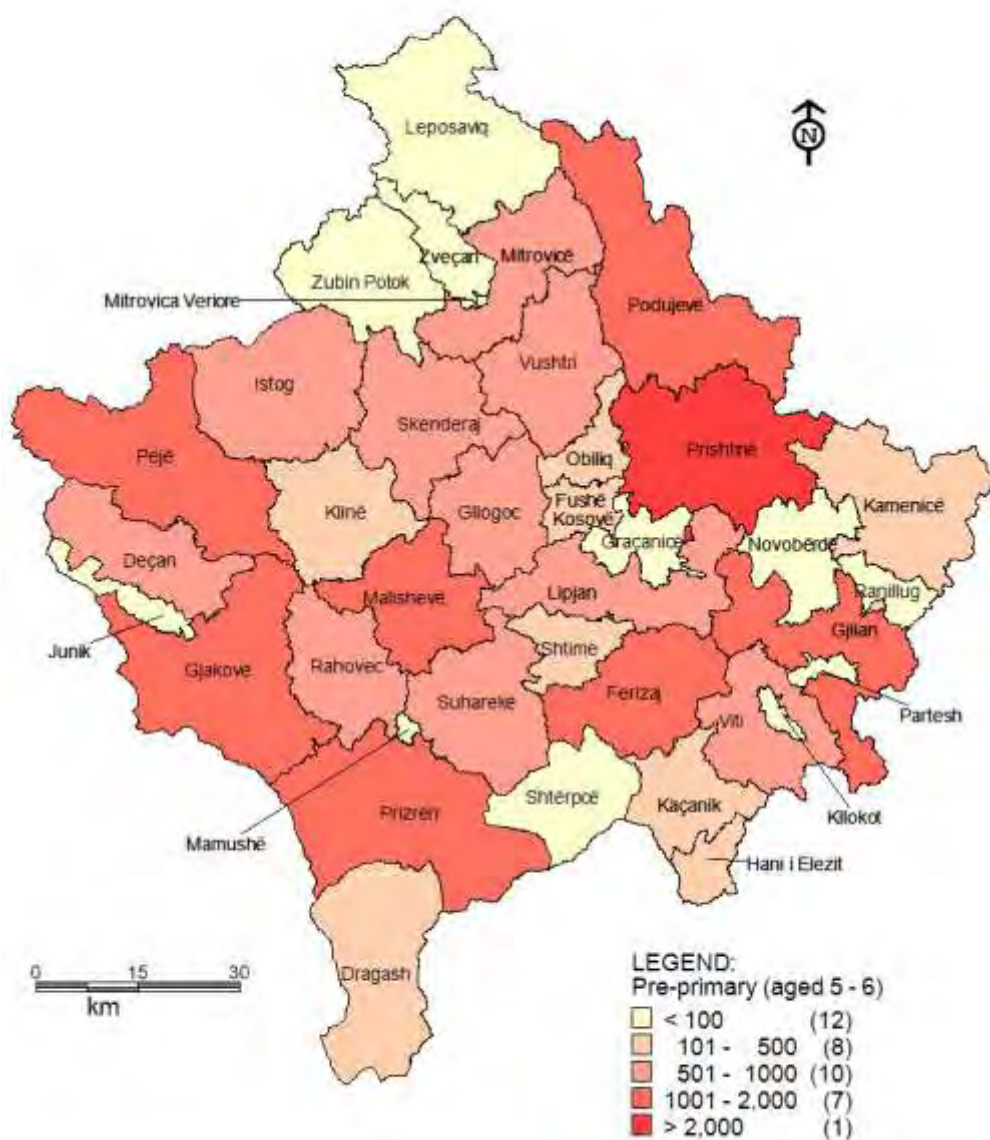

NUMBER OF CHILDREN IN PREPRIMARY EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY 2015/2016

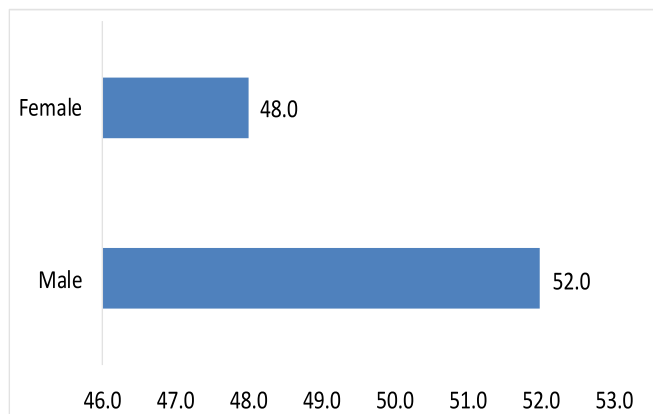

Preschool education includes children aged 5 < 6 years in kindergarten and elementary school facilities to lower secondary (ages 5 < 6 years).

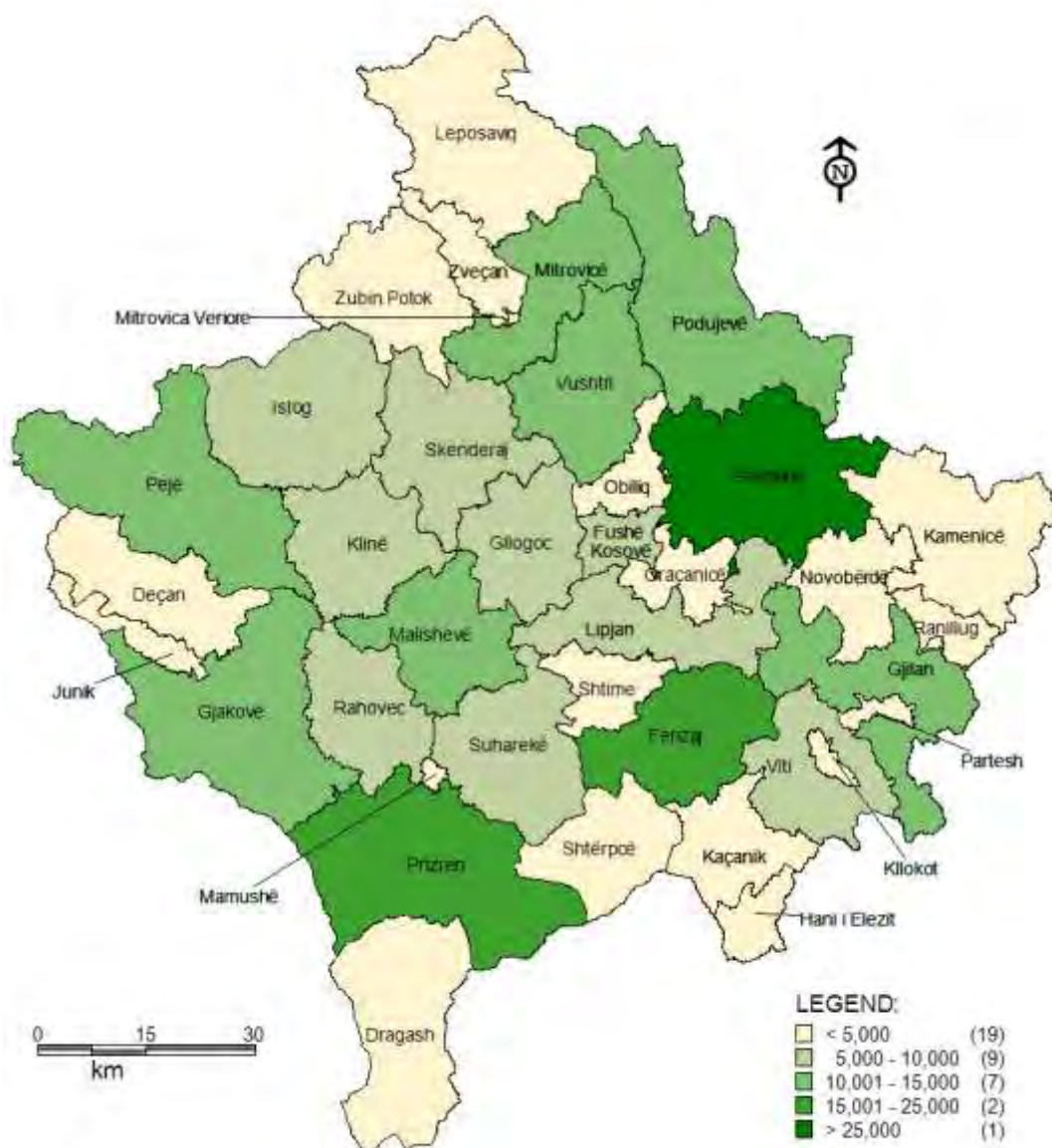

NUMBER OF PUPILS IN PRIMARY AND LOWER SECONDARY EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY 2015/2016

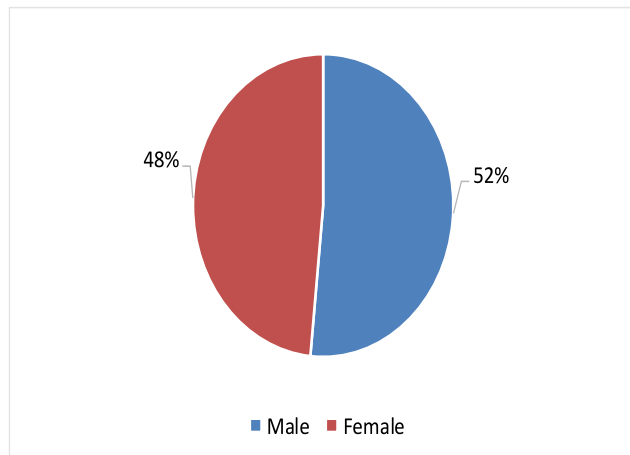

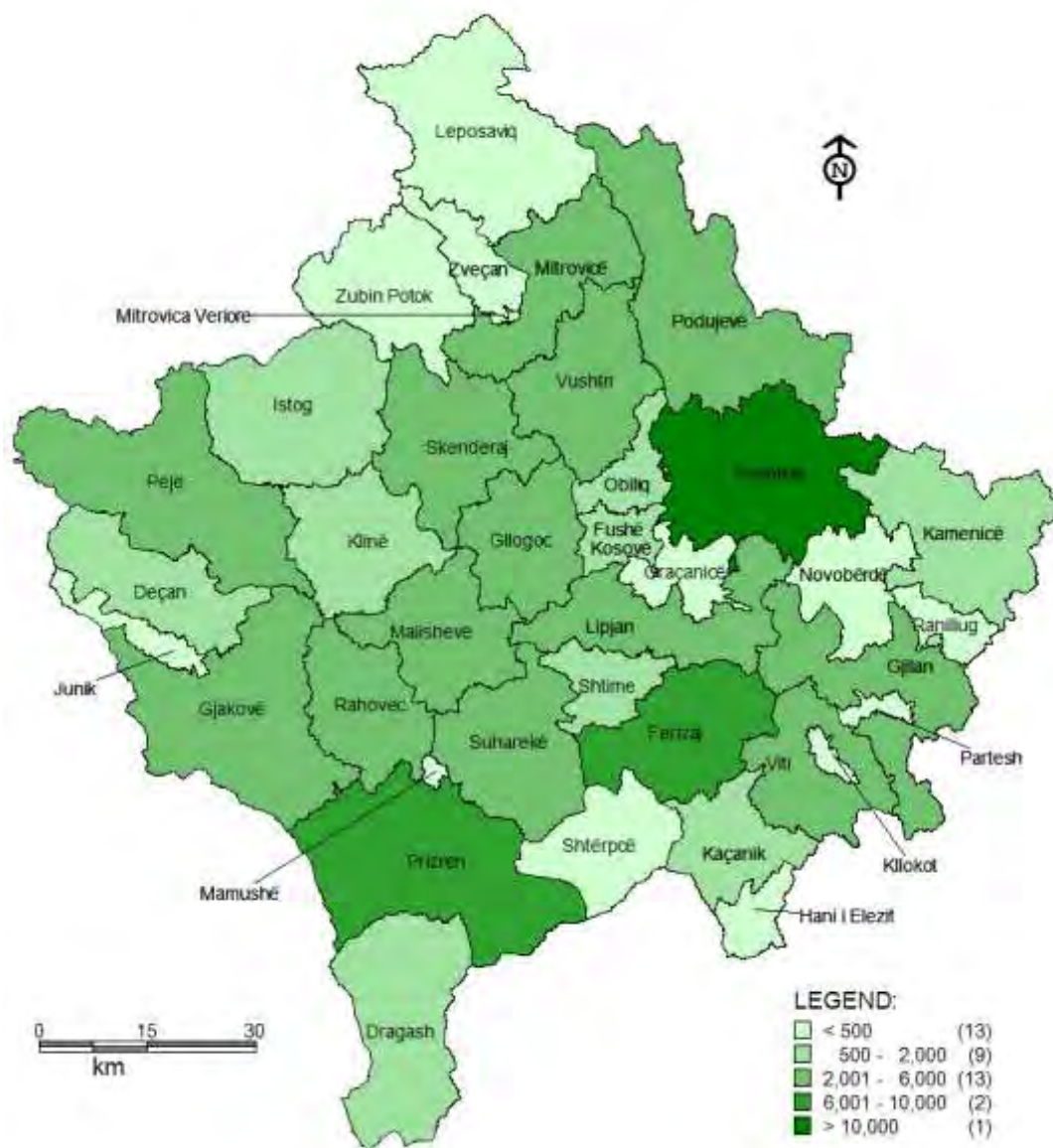

EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY 2015/2016

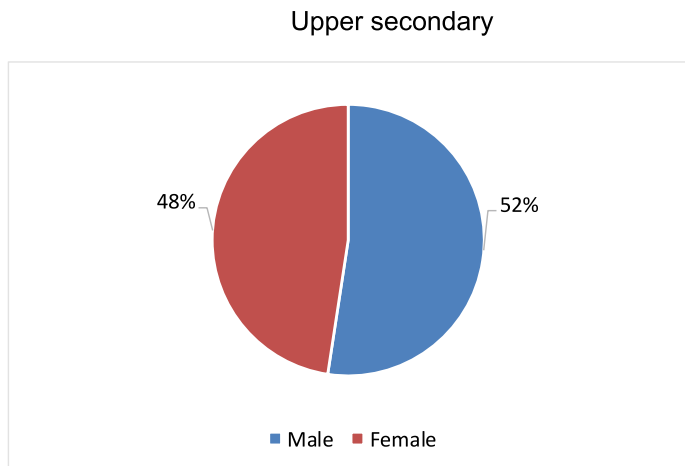

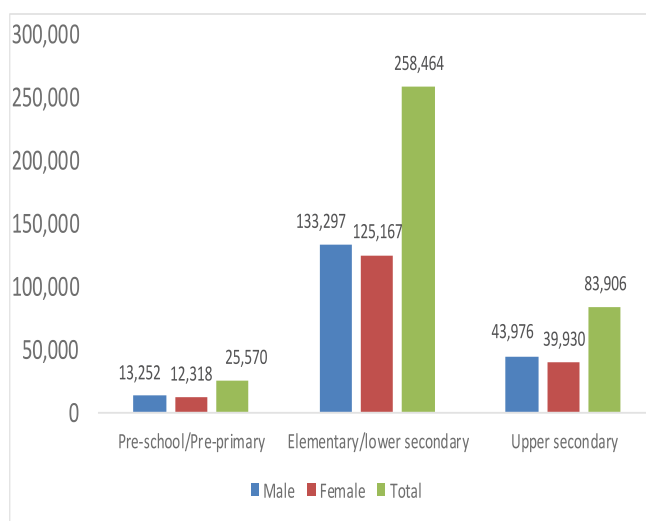
Graph. 4. Gender structure in upper secondary education

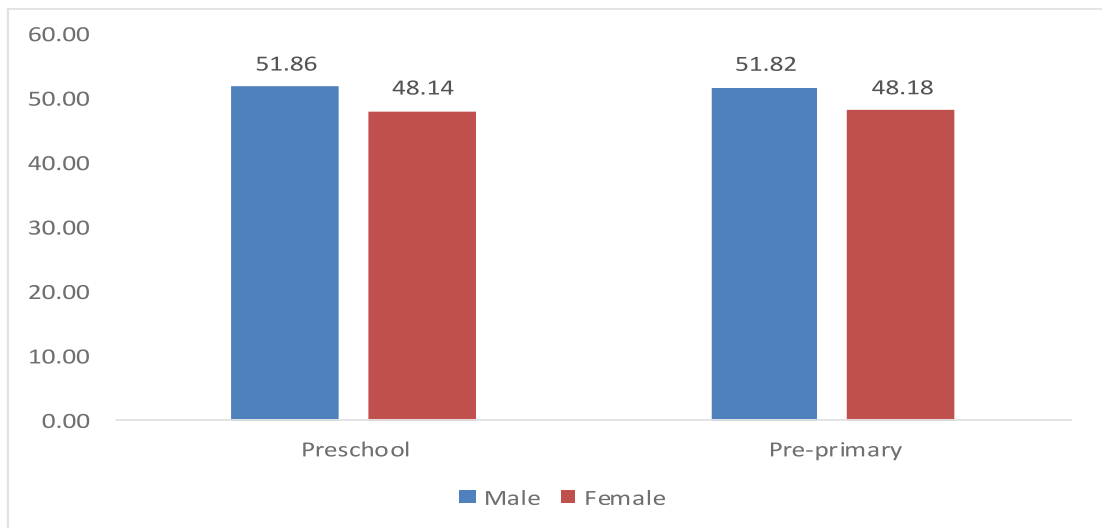
Graph. 5. Number of pupils by level

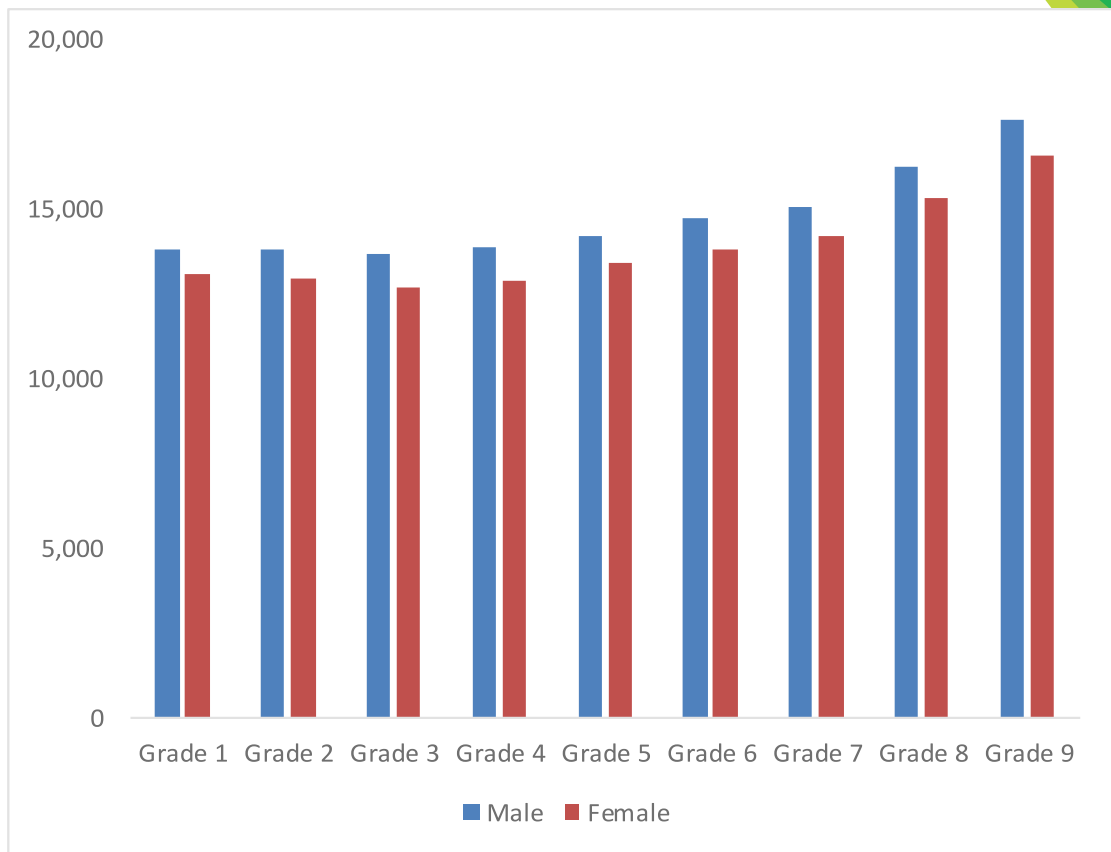


Graph. 6. The number of children in pre-school / pre-primary level

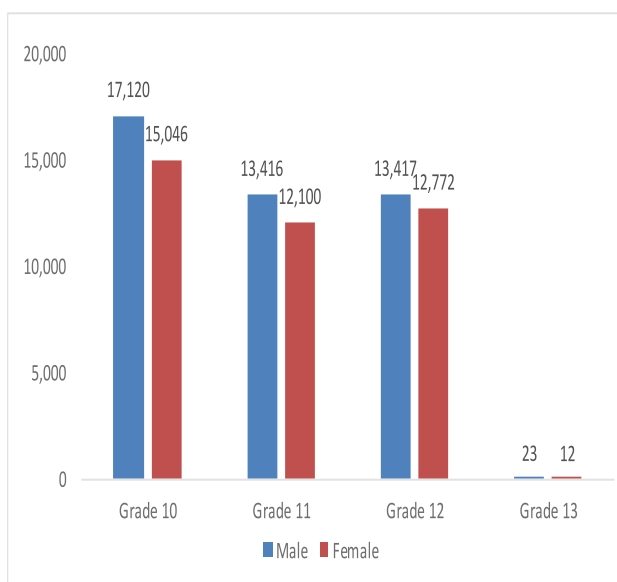


Graph. 7. The number of pupils in primary – lower secondary education by grade

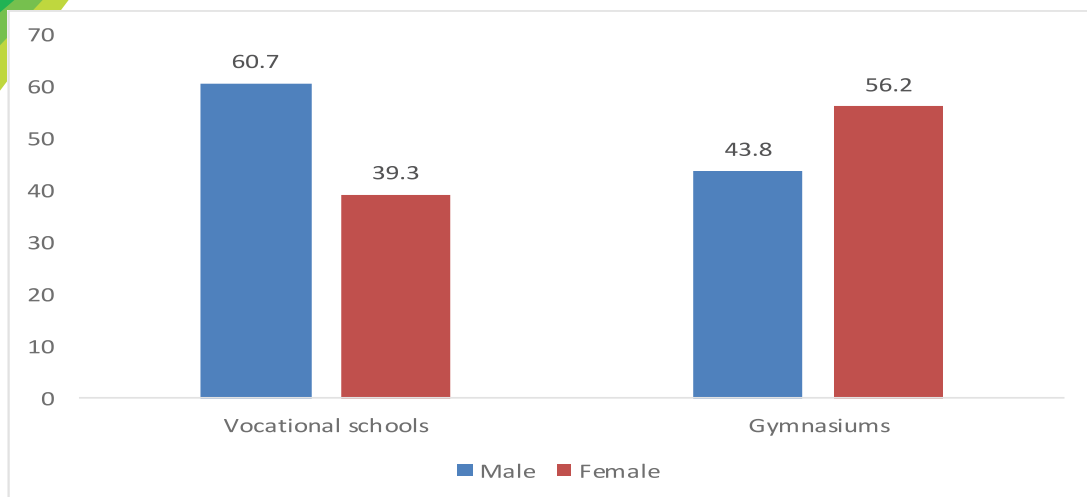


Graph. 8. Number of pupils in upper secondary education by grade

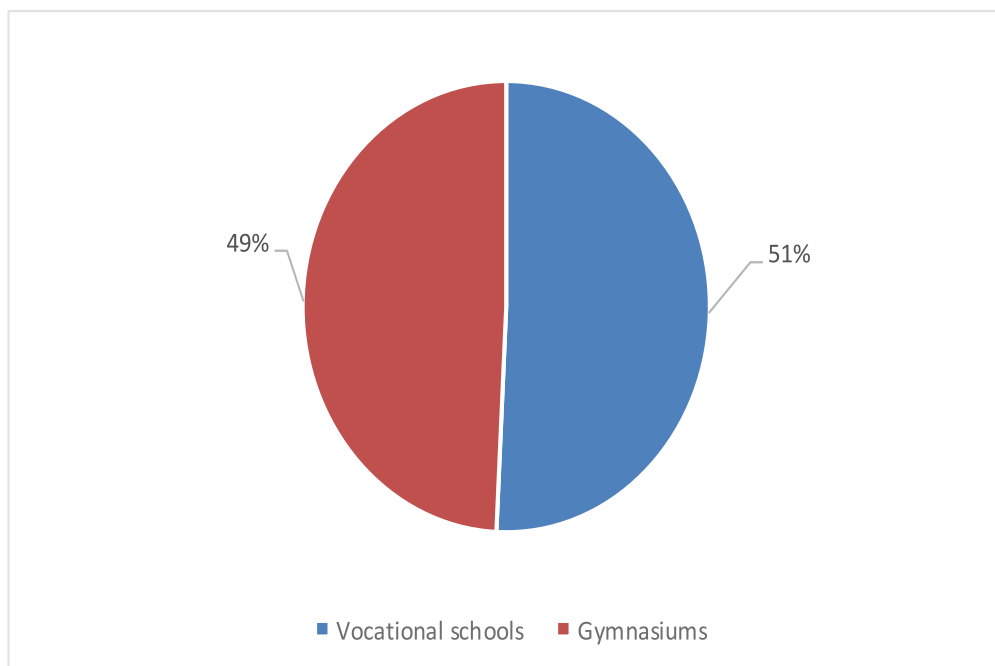

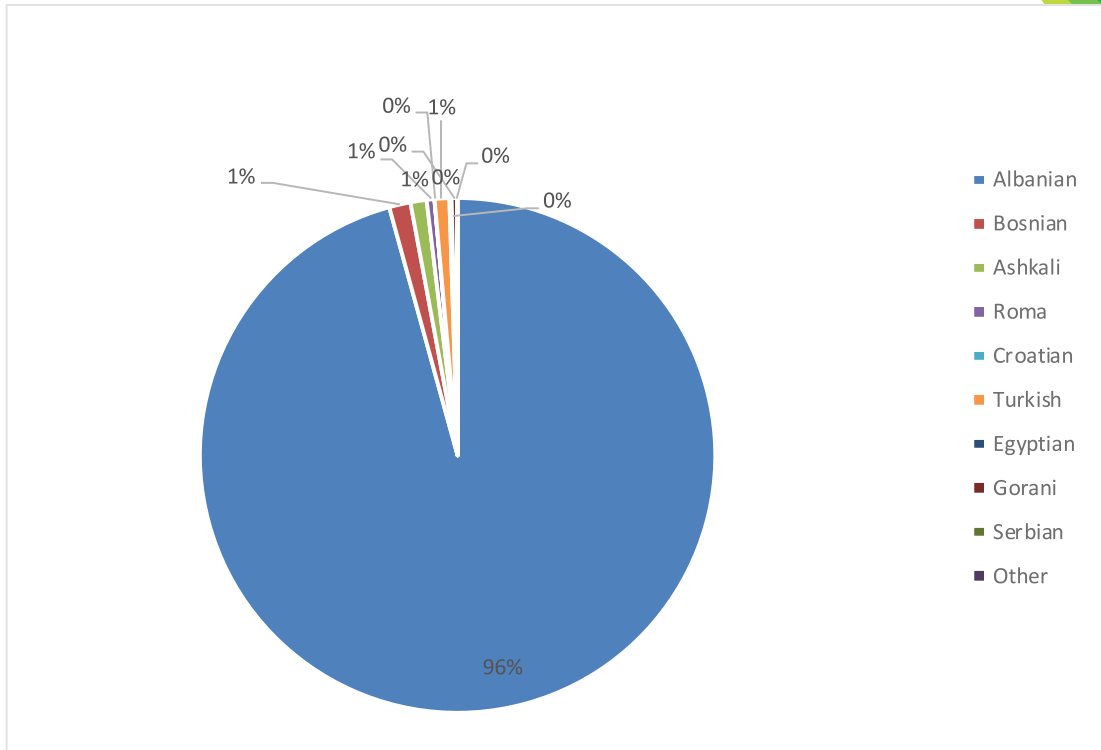

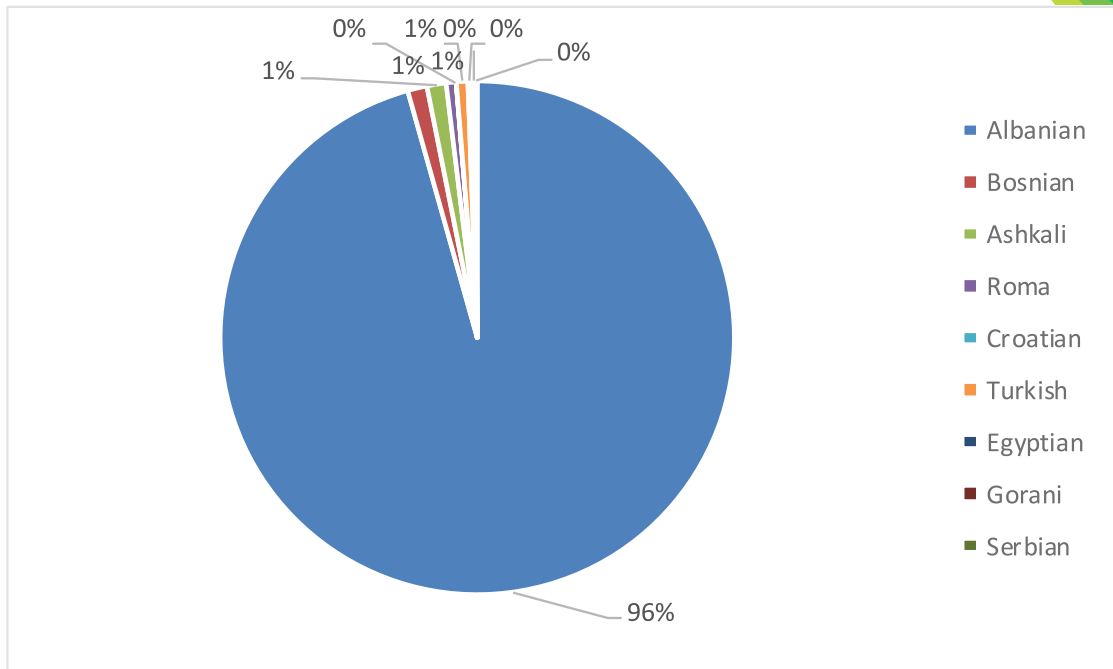
Graph.11. Number of children in pre-primary education by ethnicity in%

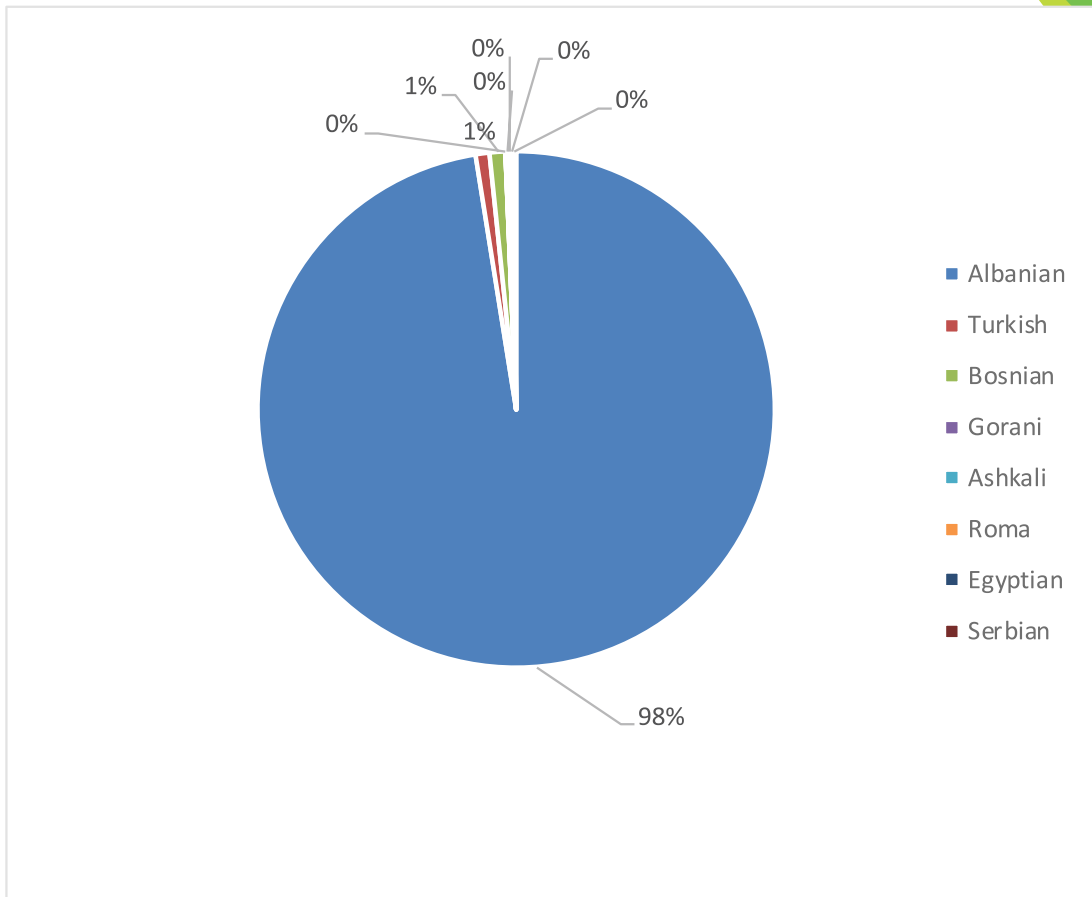
Graph.12. Number of pupils in primary and lower secondary education by ethnicity in%

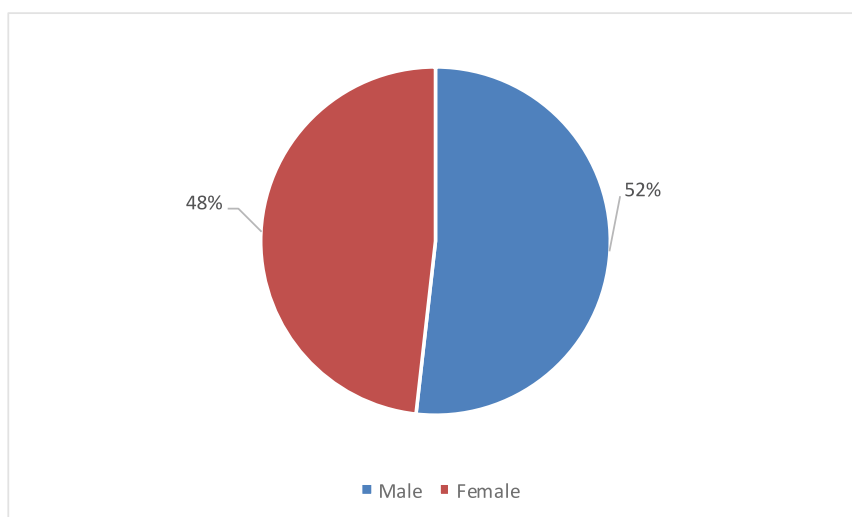


Graph.13. Number of pupils in upper secondary education by ethnicity in%

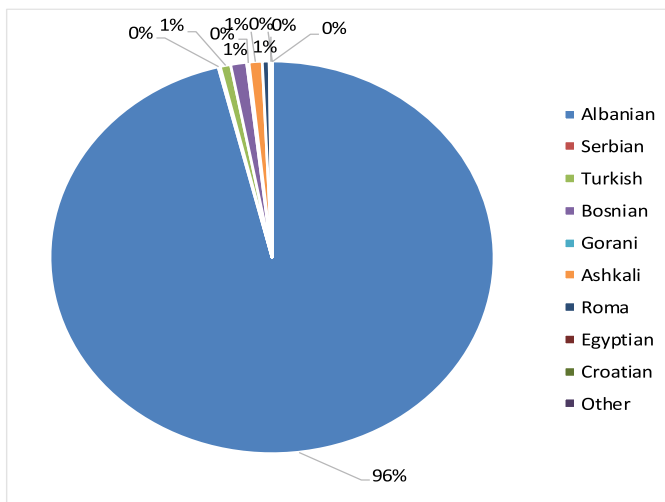
Graph.14. Gender structure in pre-university education

Graphf.15. Ethnic structure of pre-university education

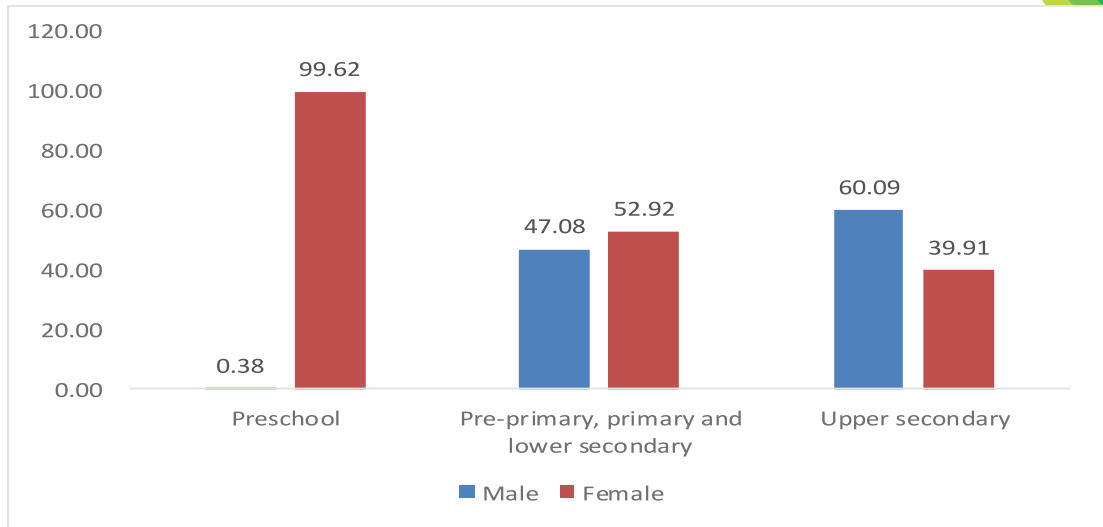

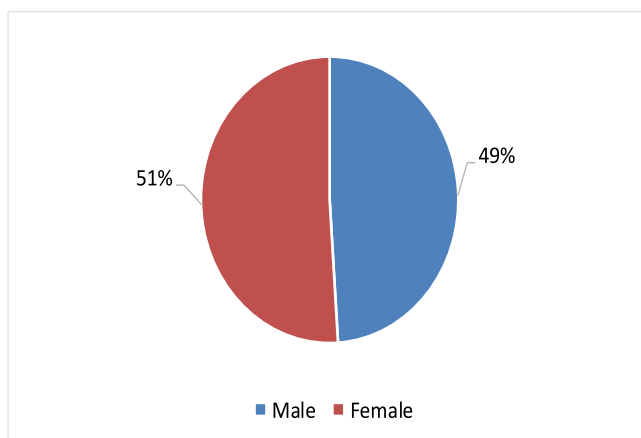


Graph.16. Teachers by level in%

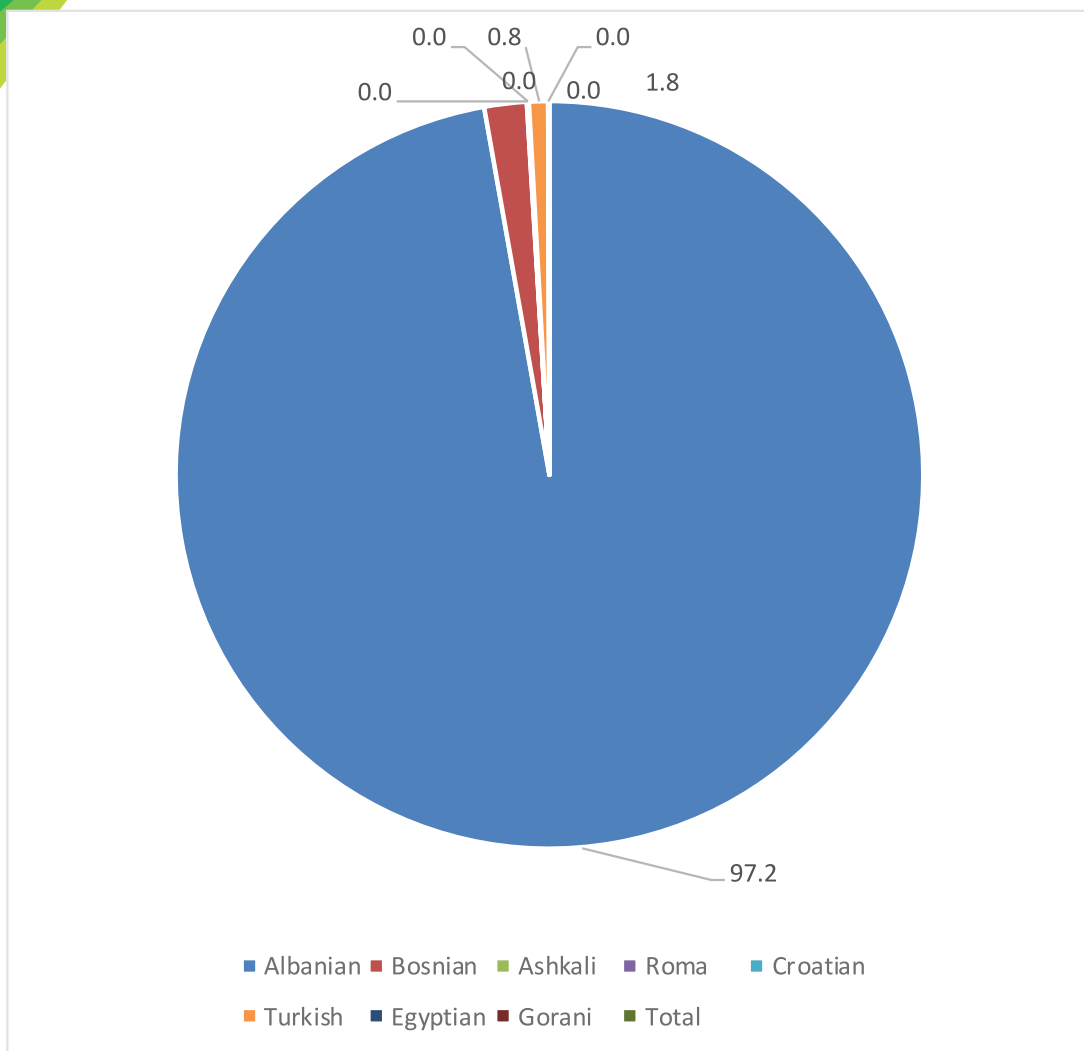
Graf.17. Teachers by gender in%

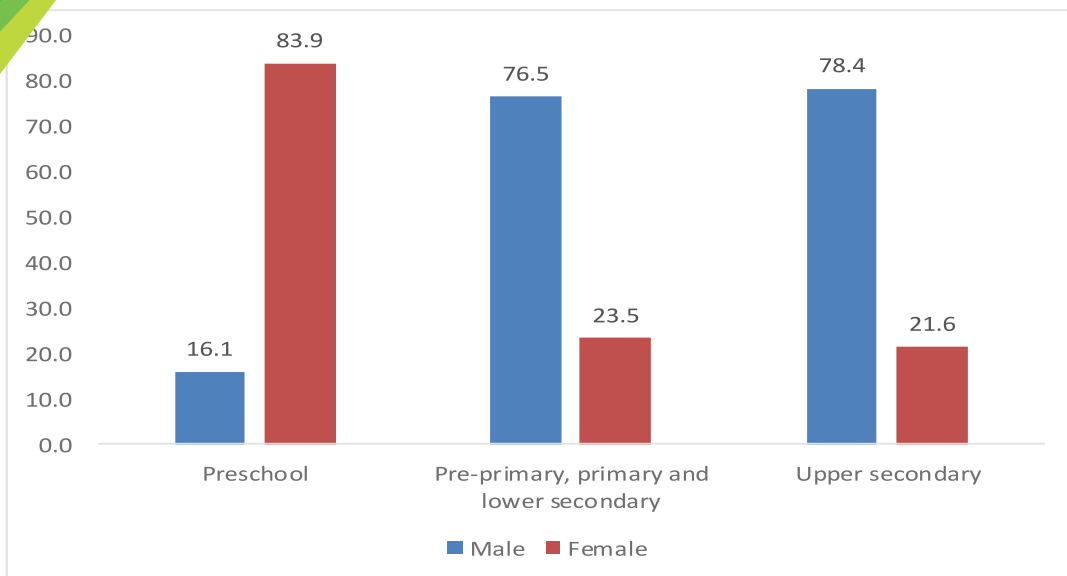


Graph.18. Teachers by ethnicity in%

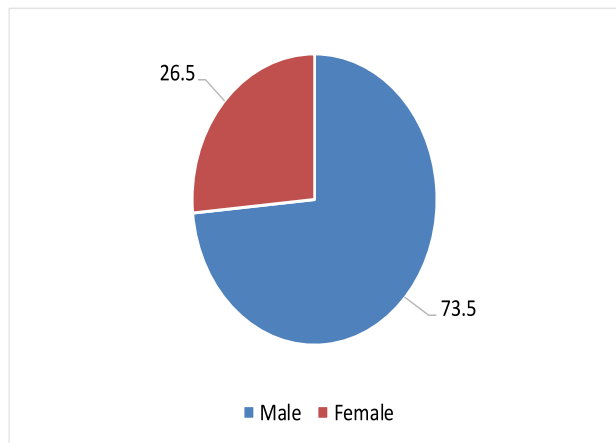


Graph.19. Administrative staff by gender for the level in%

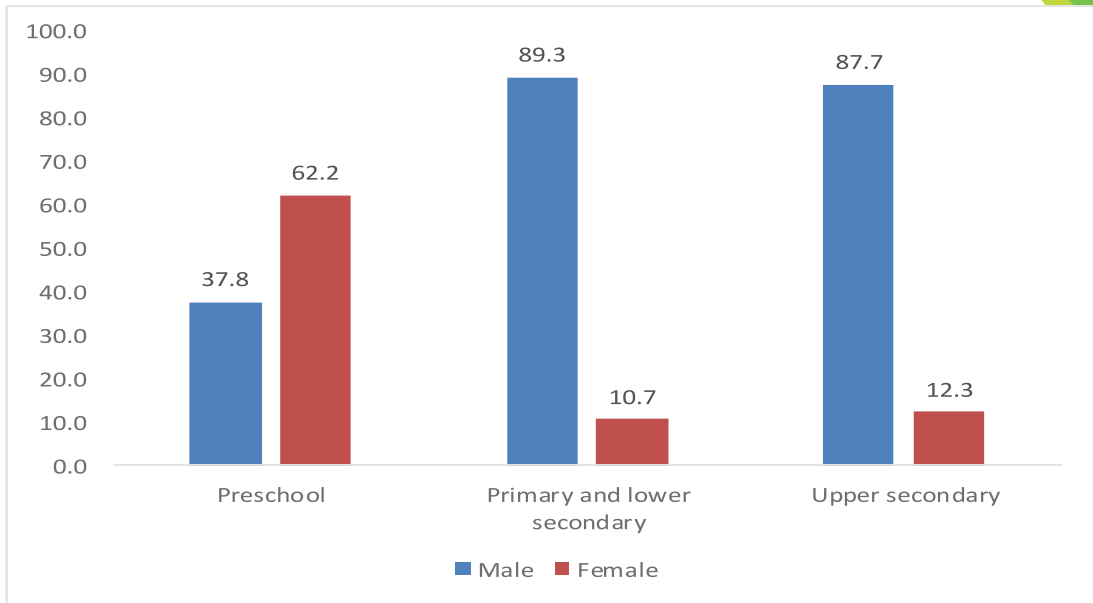


Graph.20. Administrative staff by gender in%

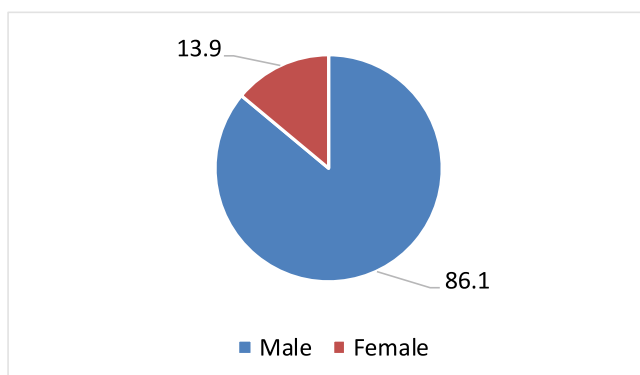


Graph.21. Support staff according to level in%

Graph. 22. Support staff by gender in%

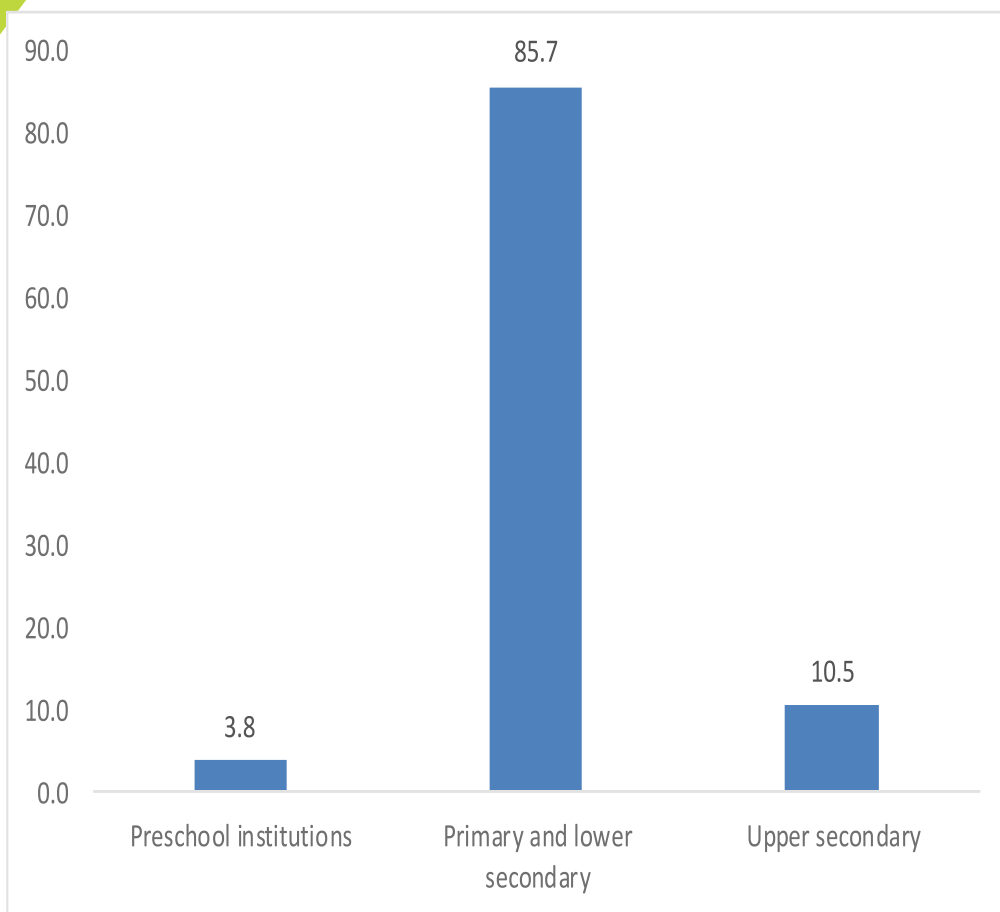

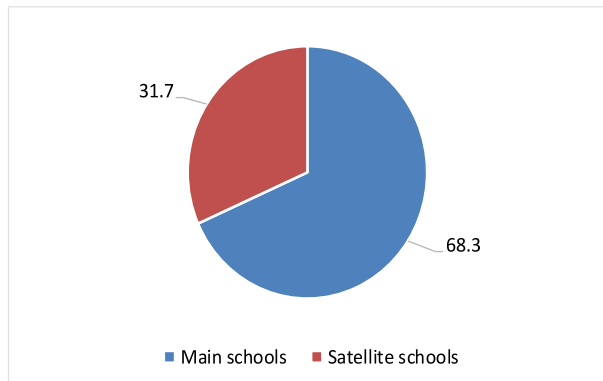
Graph.23. Educational institutions by level

Graph.24. Main school institutions and satellite schools

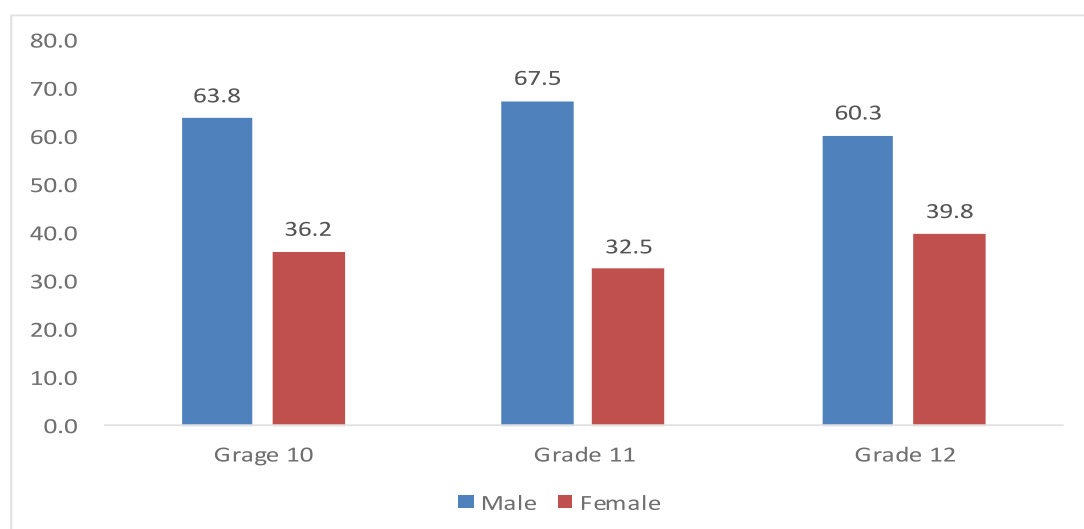

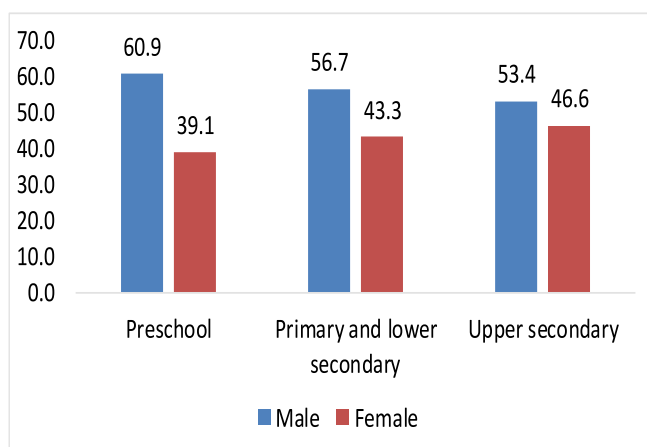

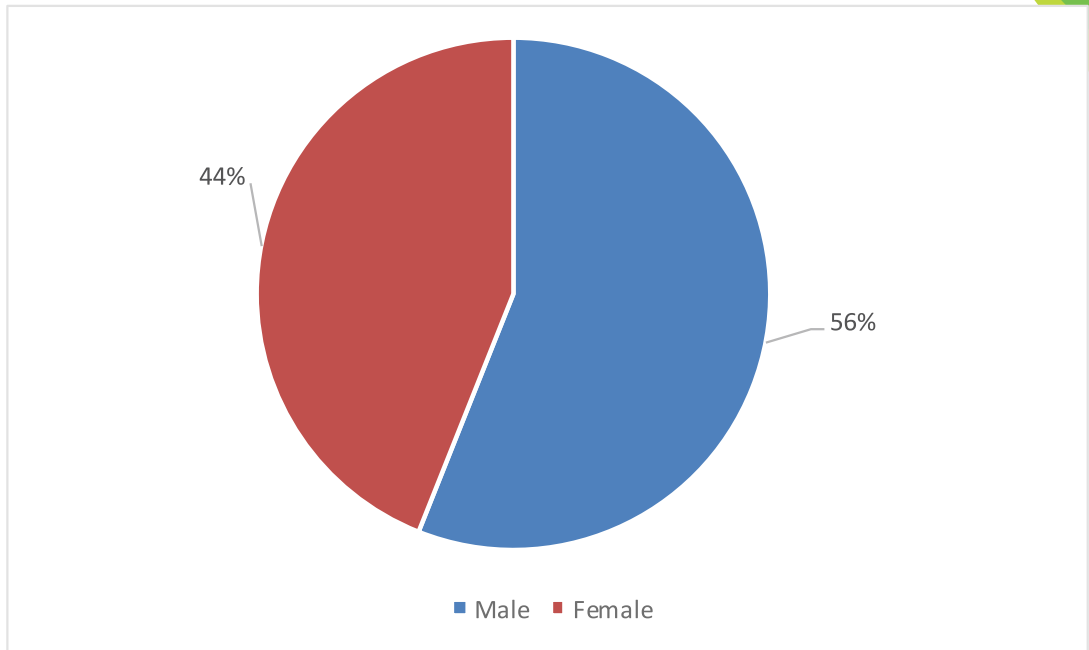

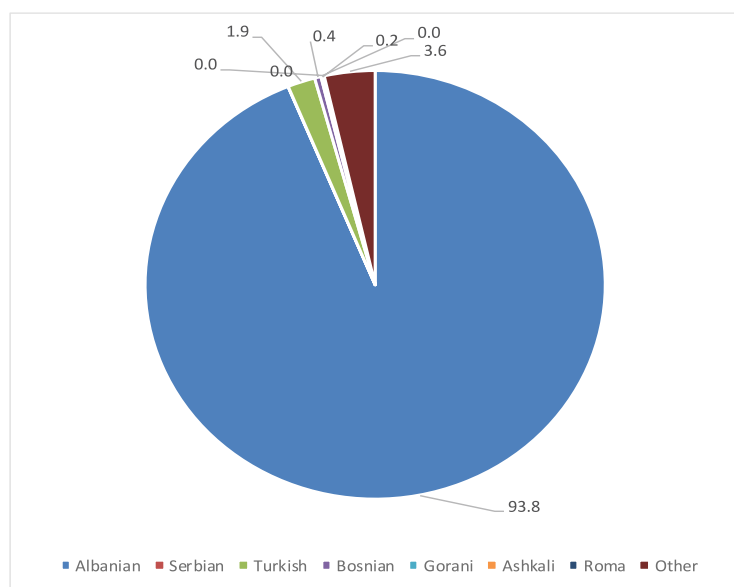


Graph.28. Pupils in private education by level

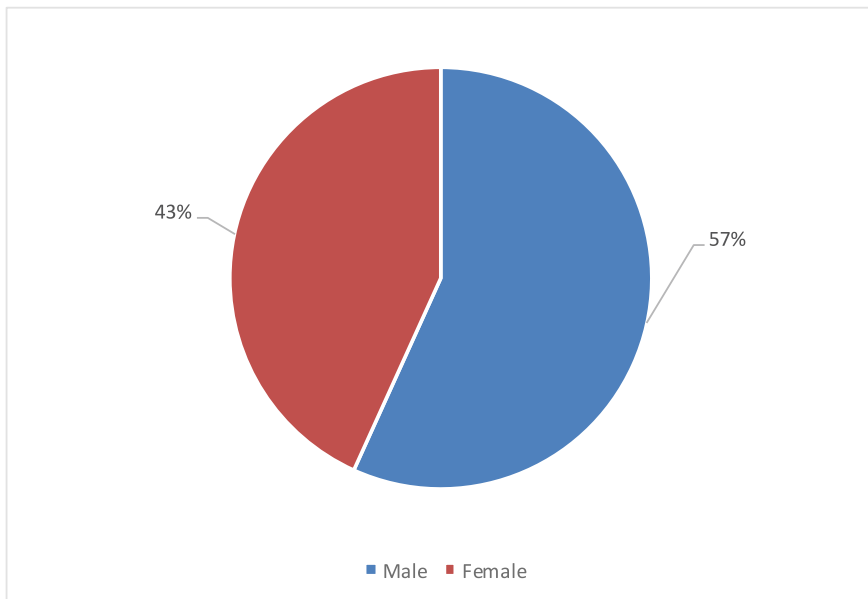


Graph.29. Pupils by ethnicity in private education

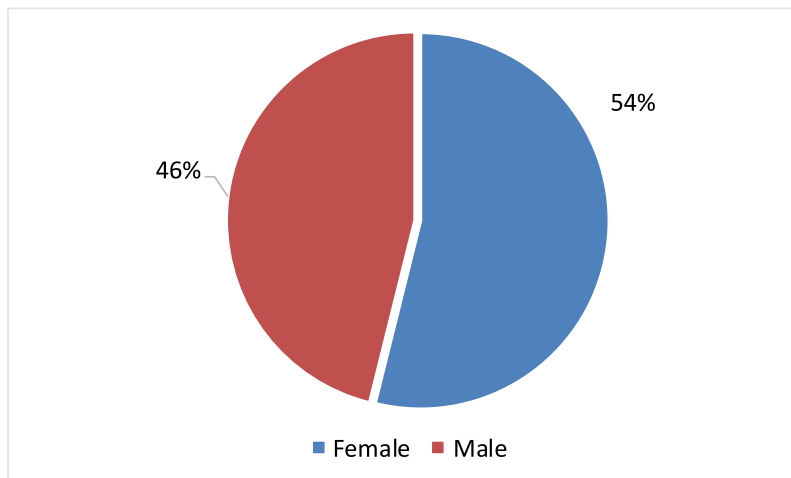

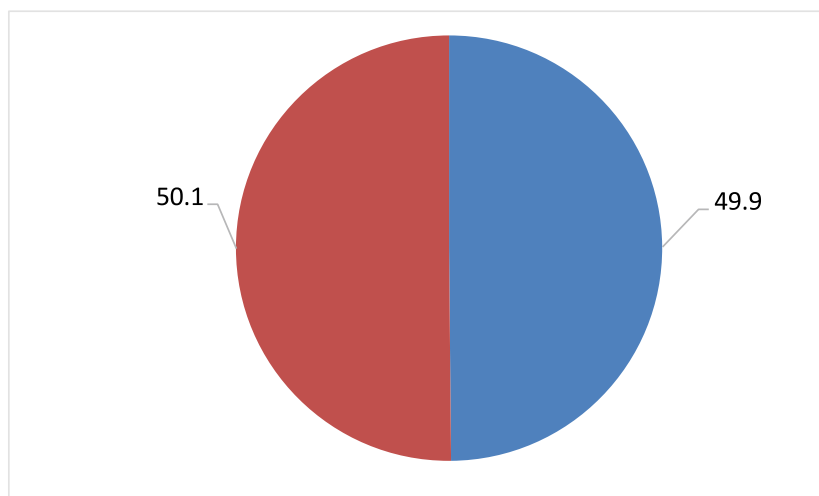
Graph.31. Gender structure in preschool education

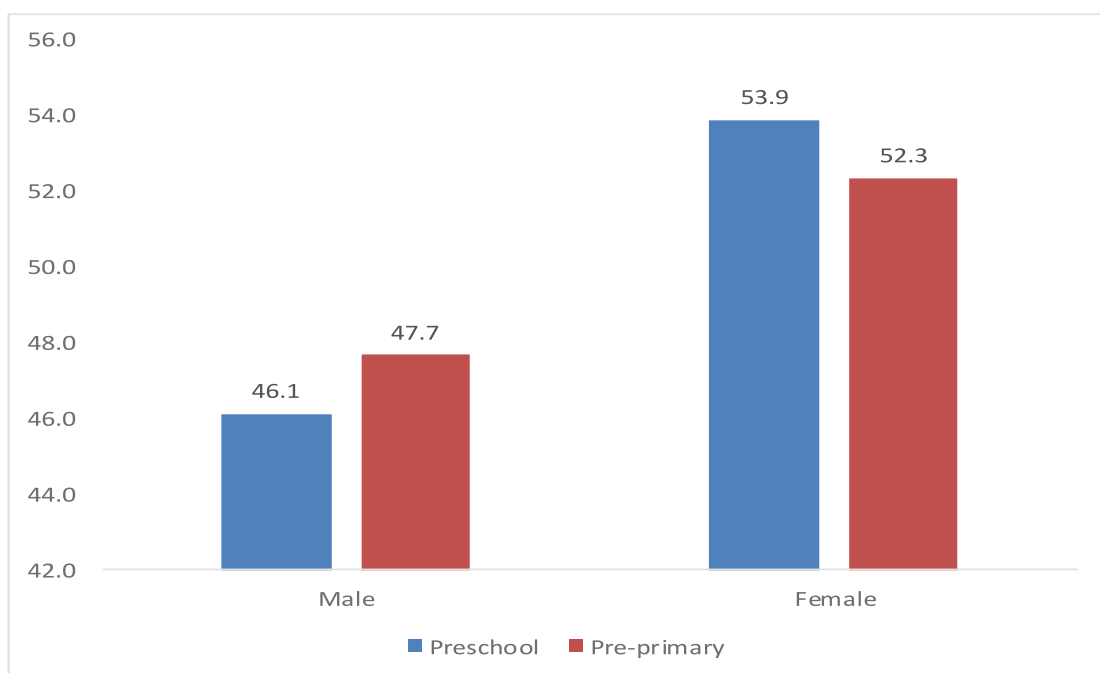

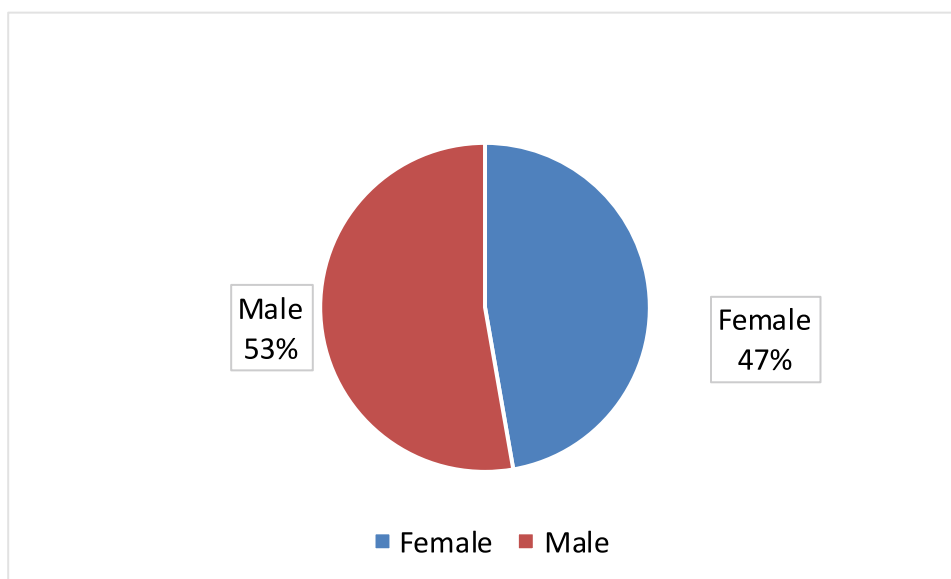
Graph.33. Number of children in pre-school / pre-primary level

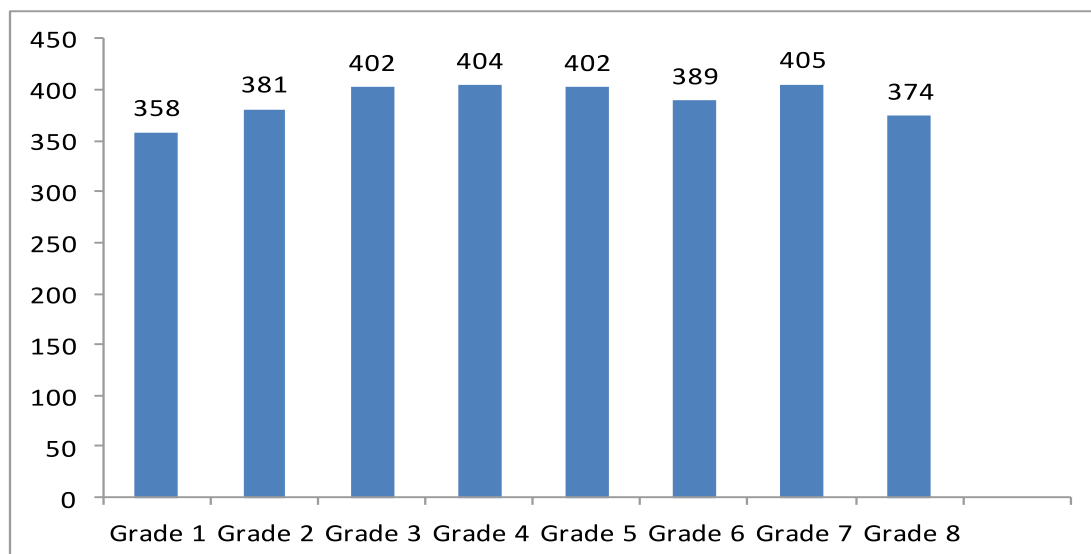

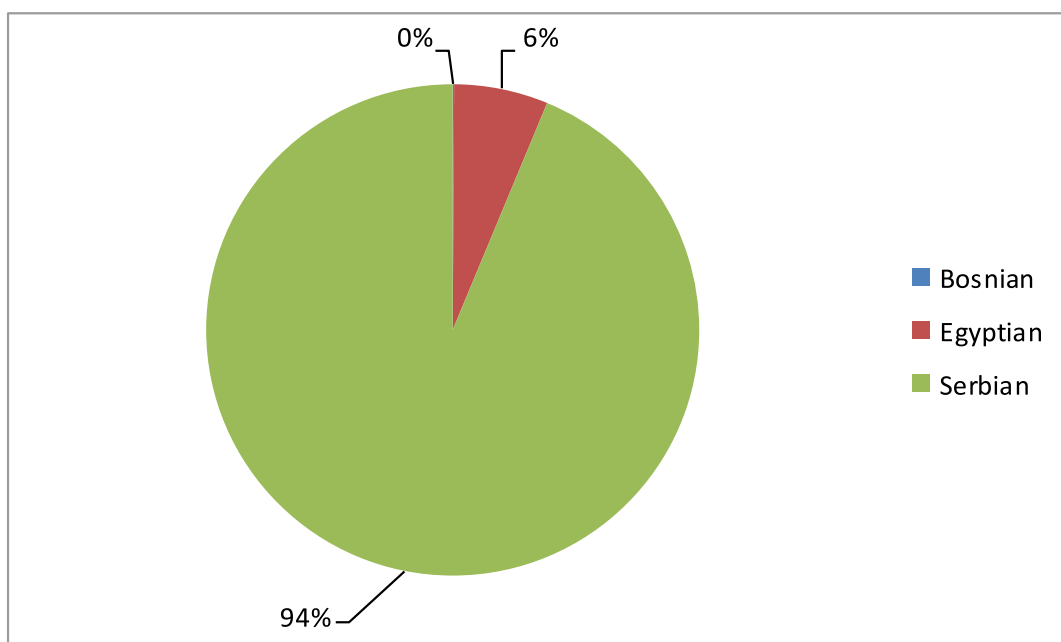

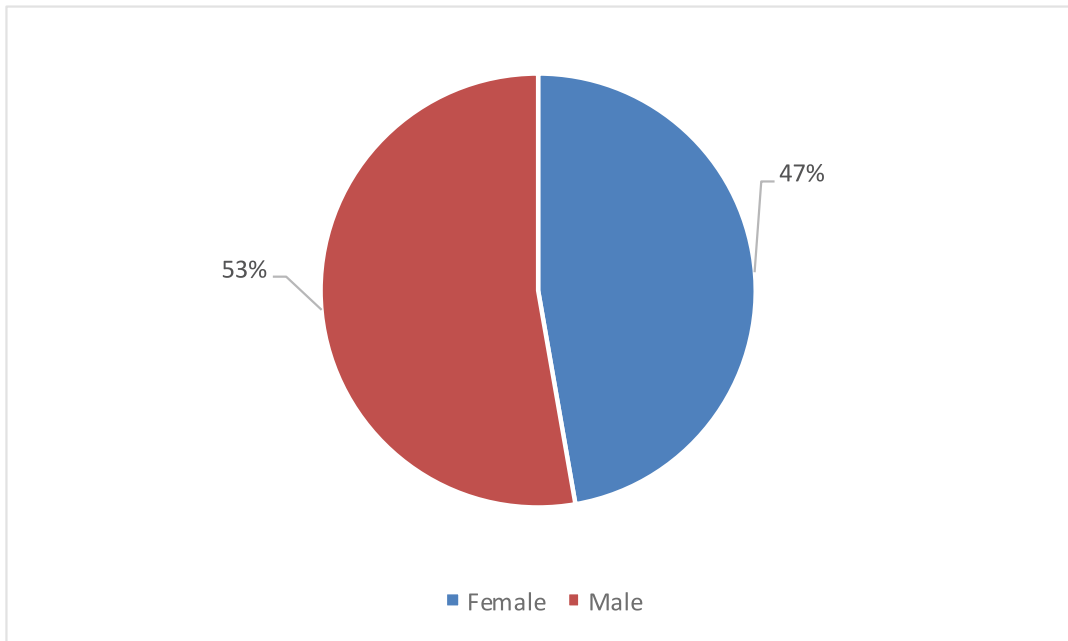

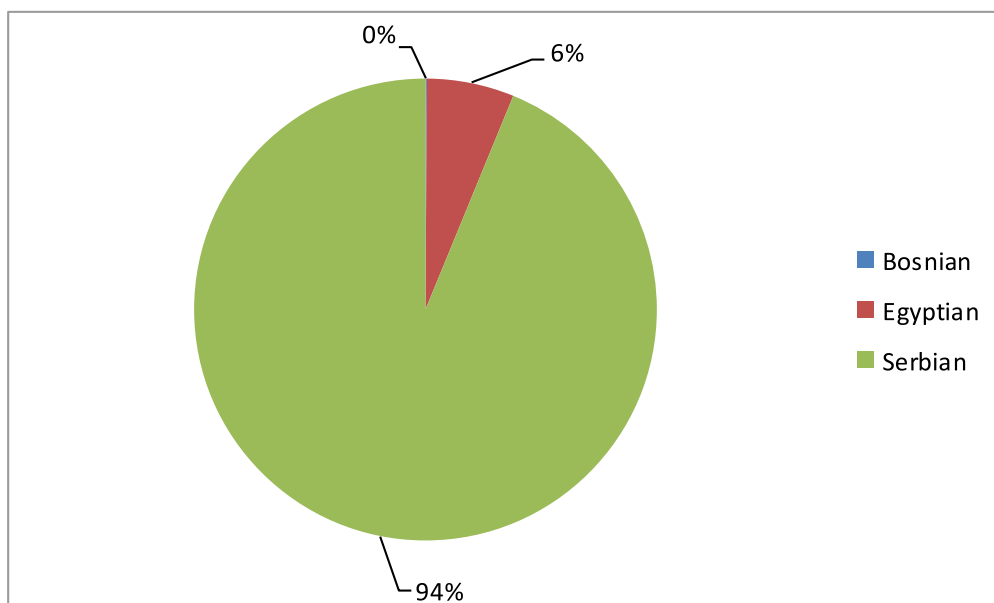

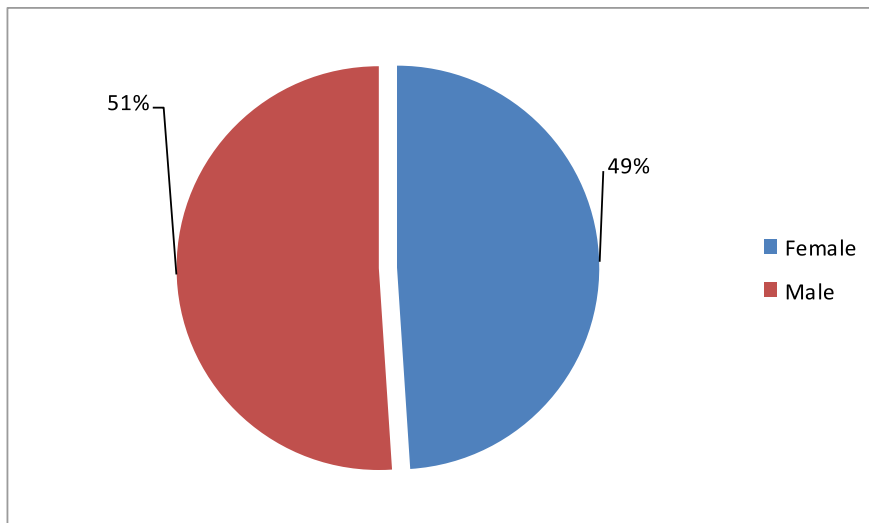


Graph. 38. Number of pupils in primary and lower secondary education by ethnicity

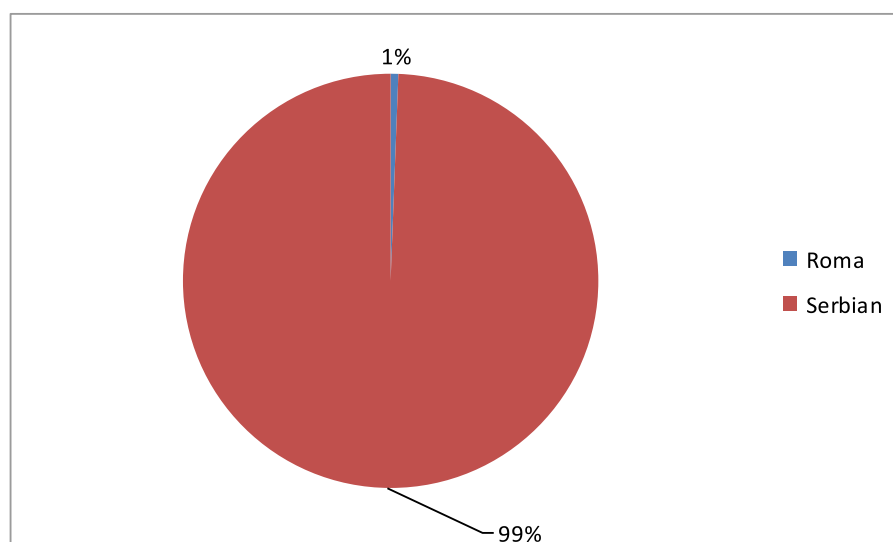

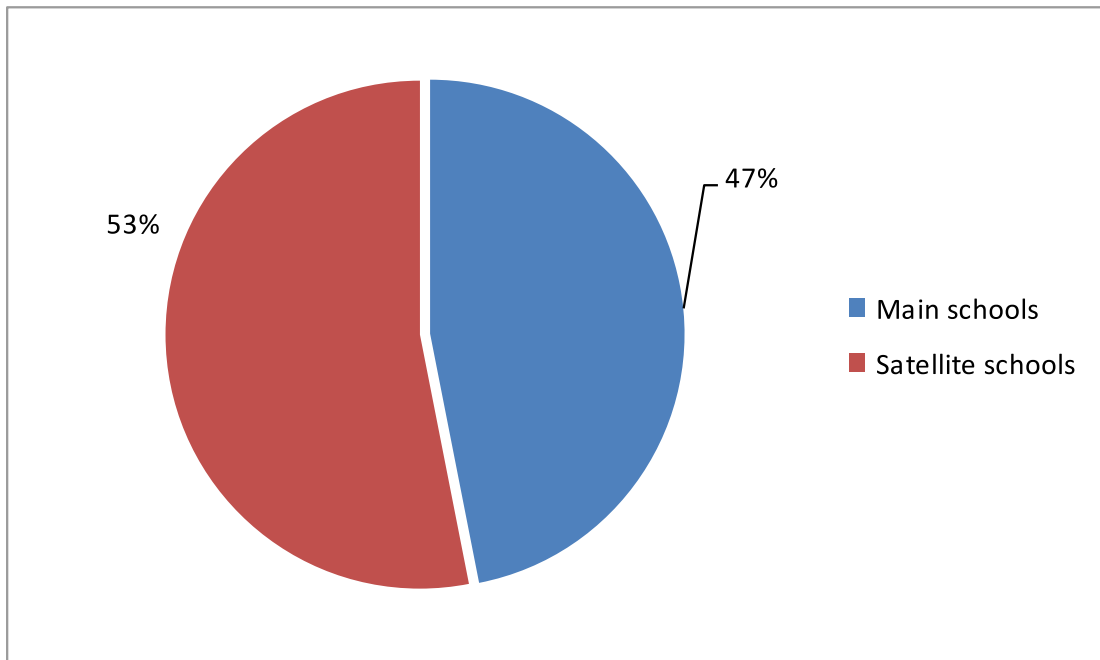

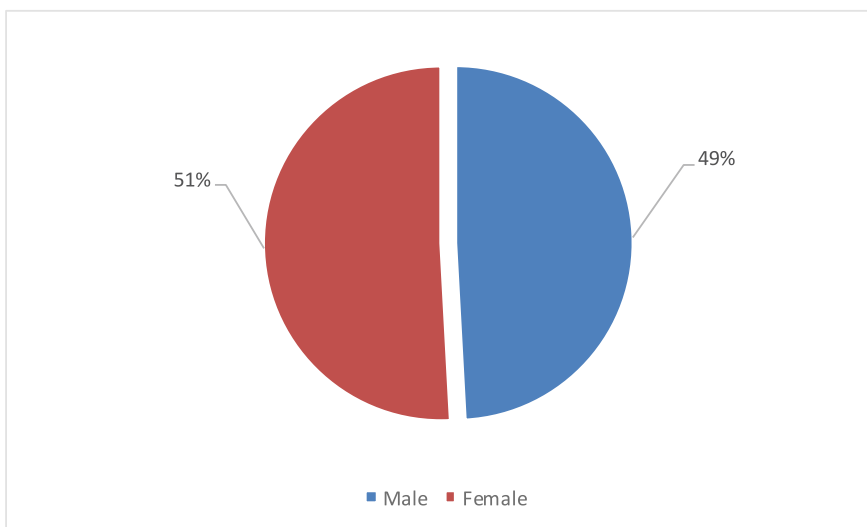

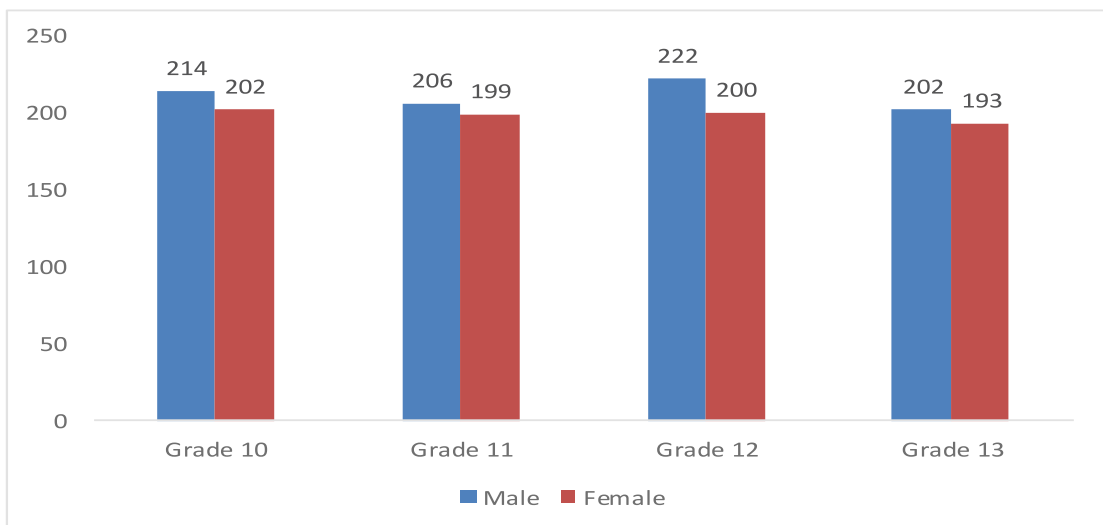

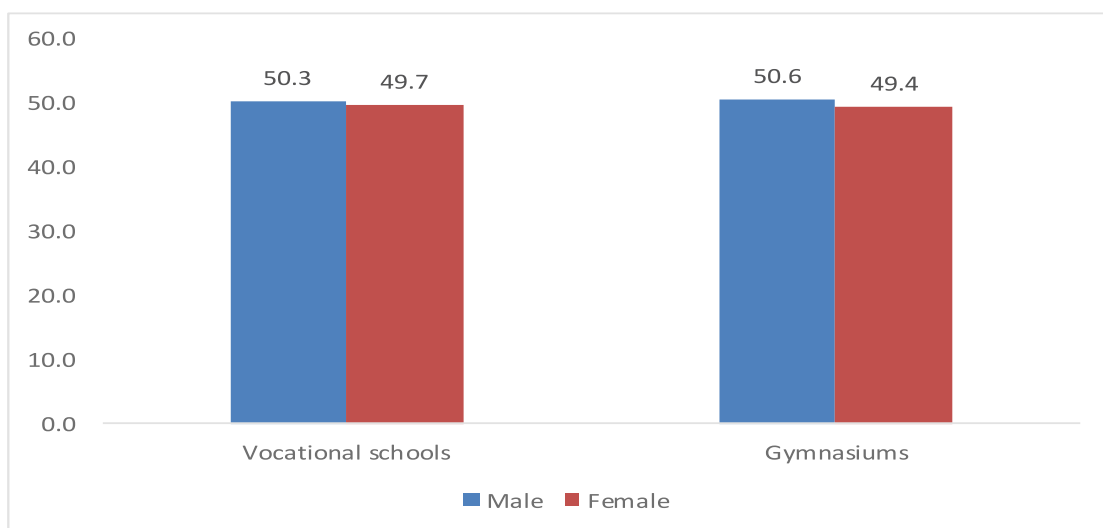

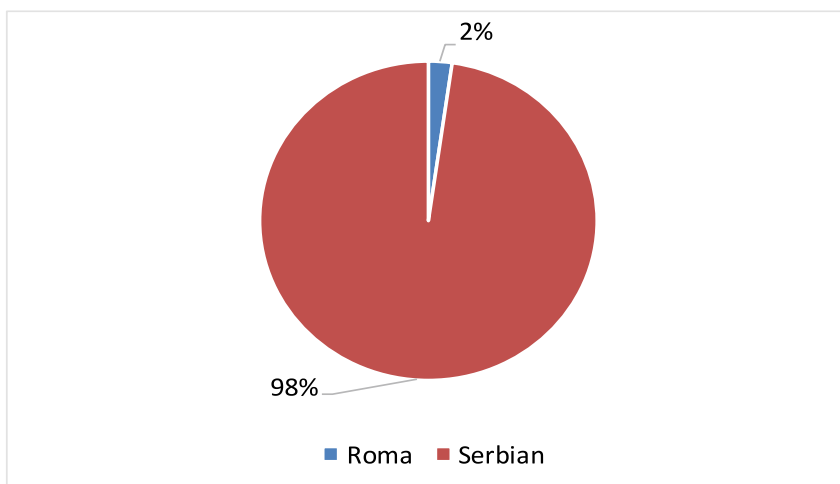

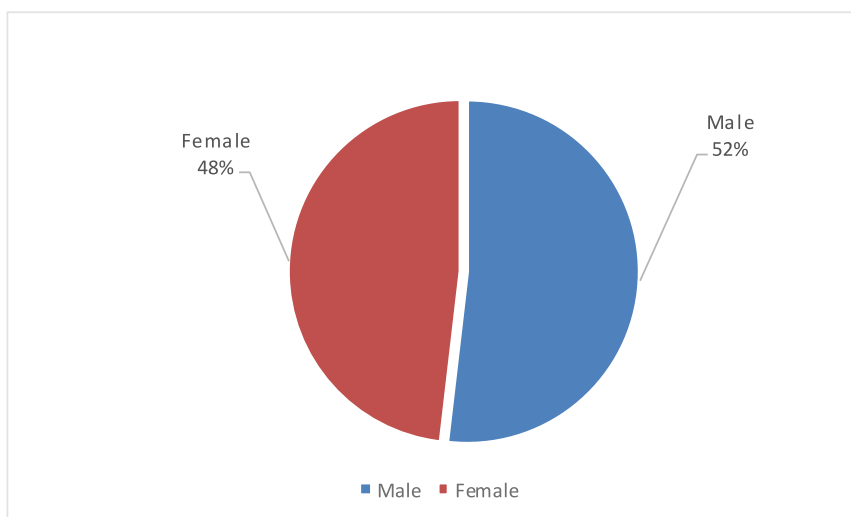


Graph.45. Number of pupils in upper secondary education by ethnicity in%

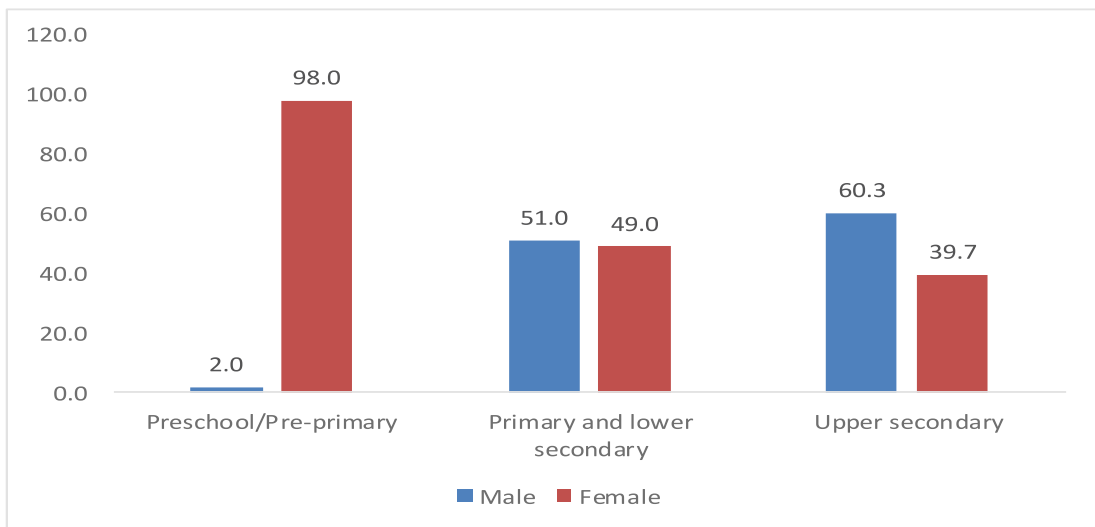


Graph.46. Gender structure of pre-university education

Graph.48. Number of active students in%

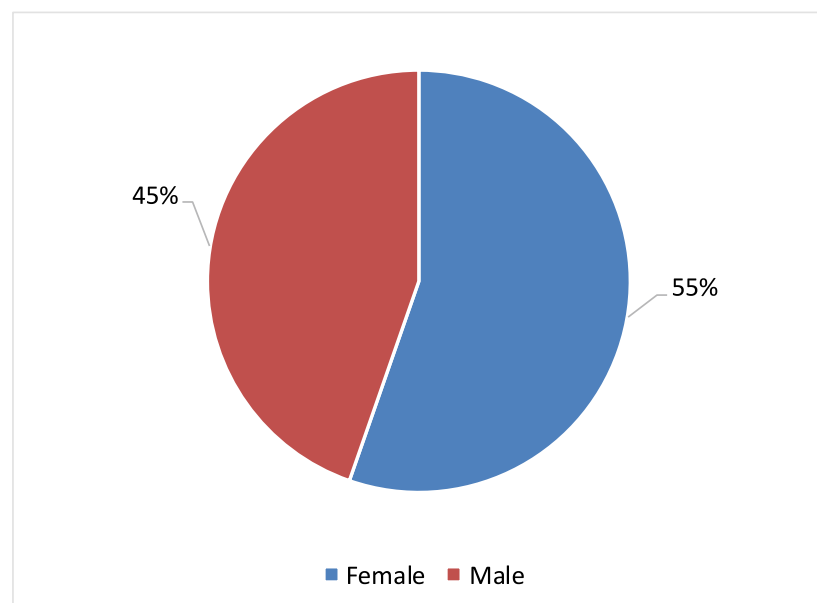

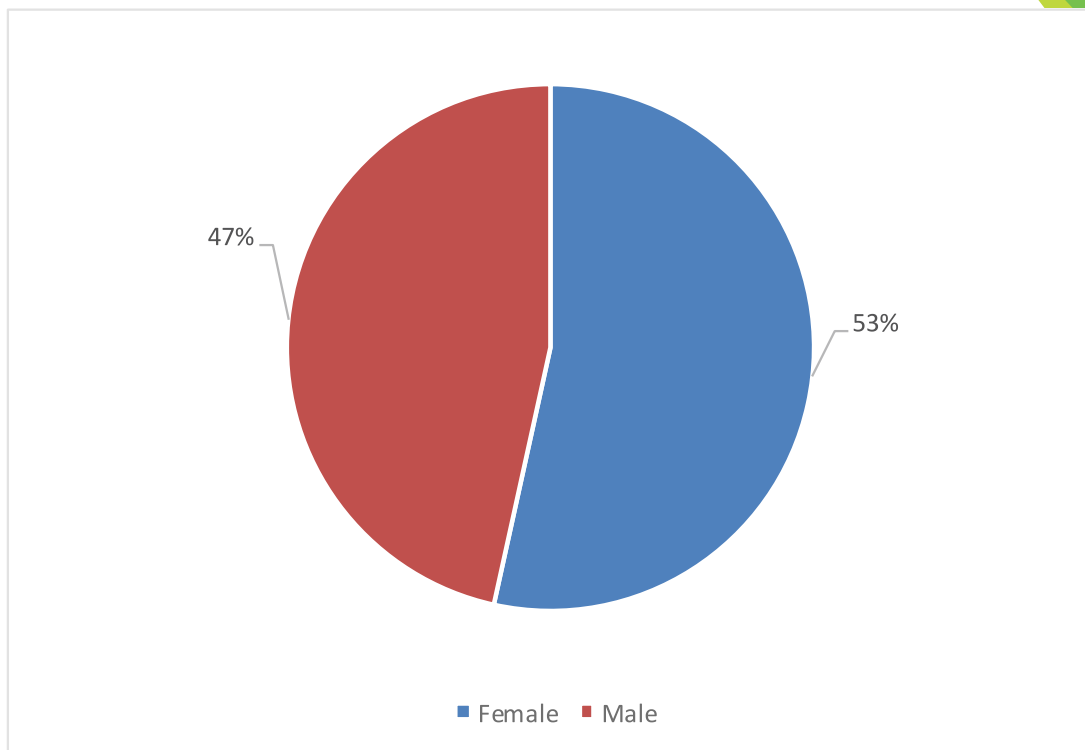

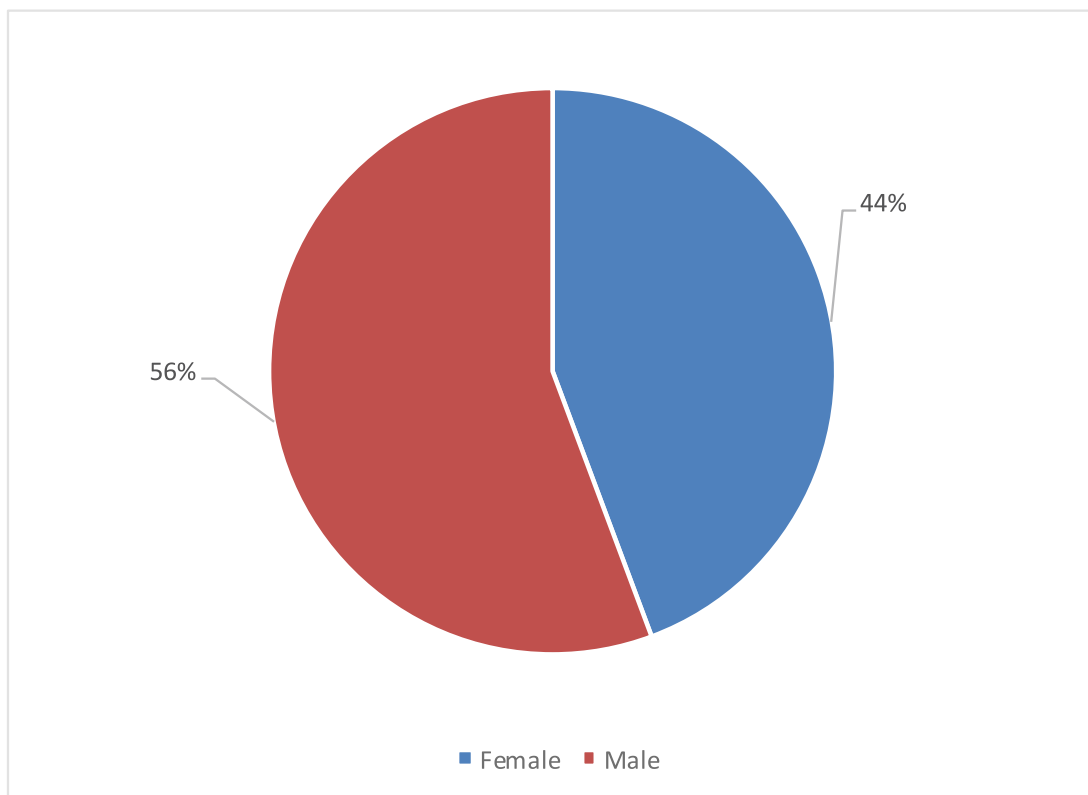

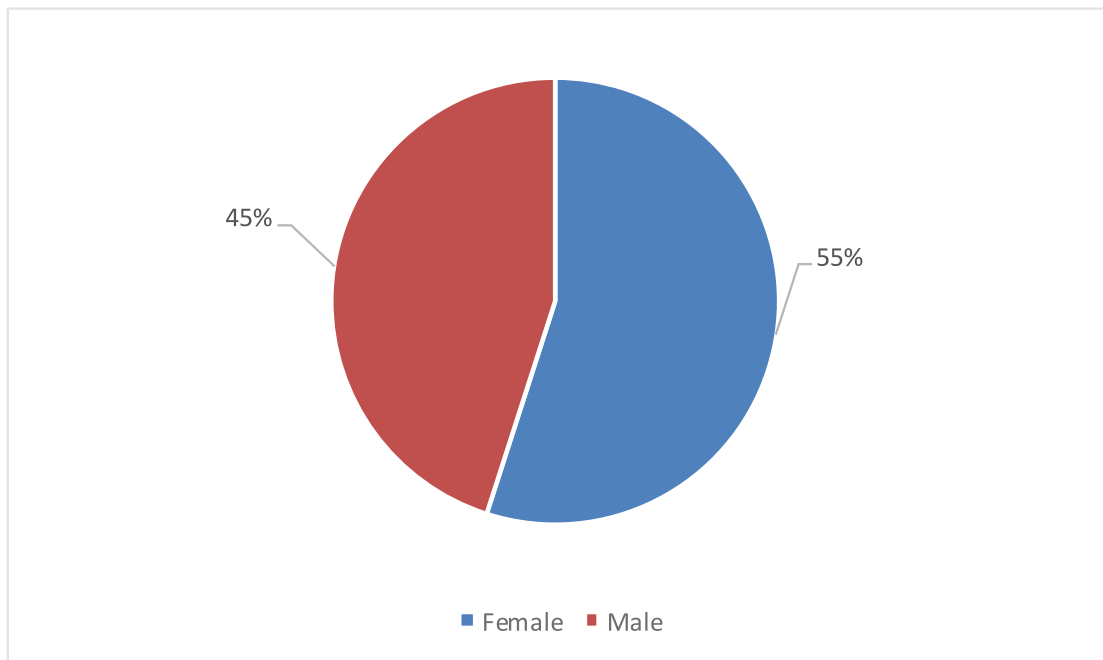

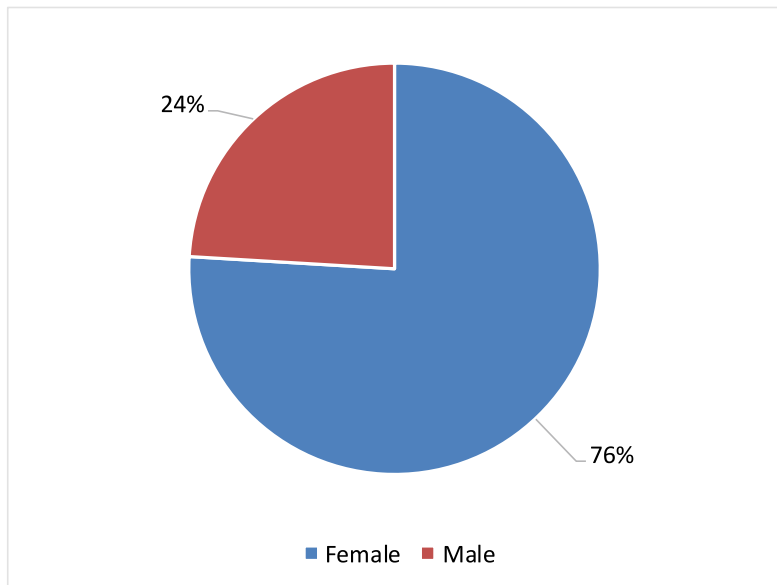

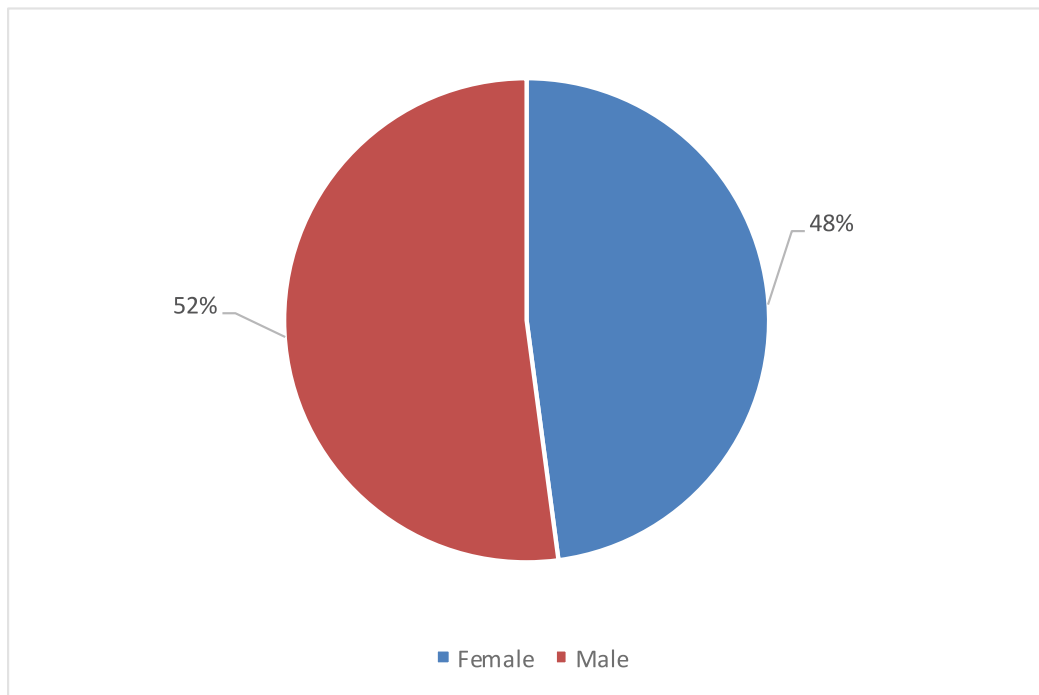

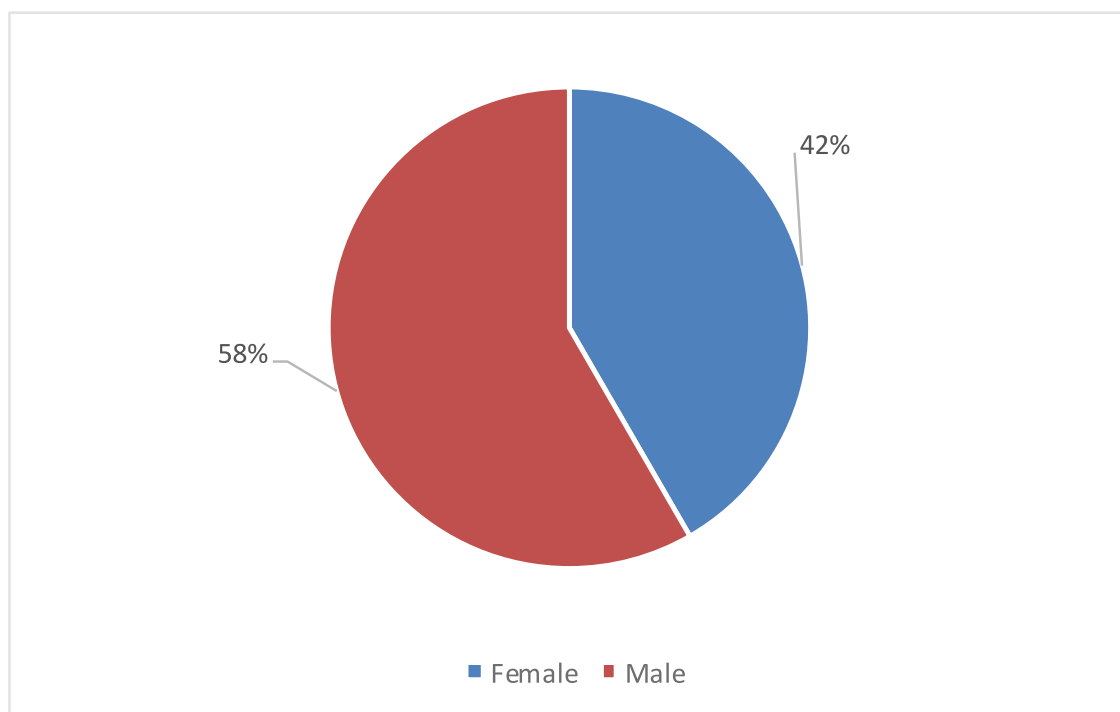

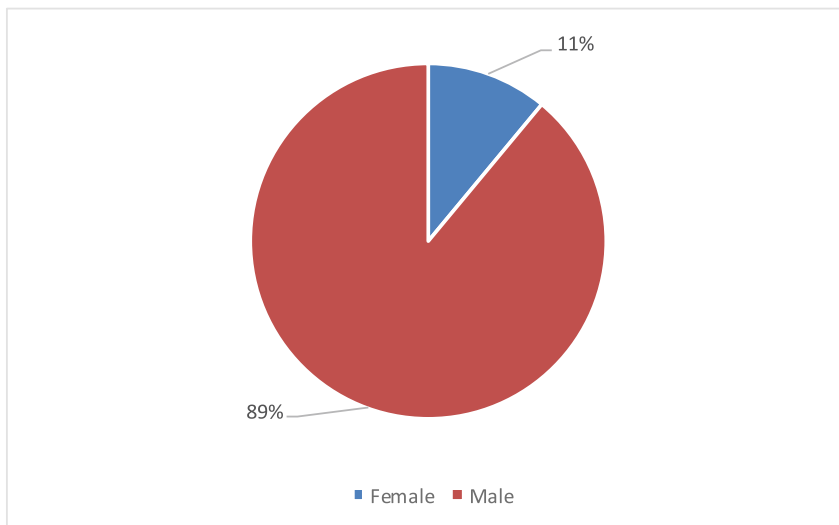

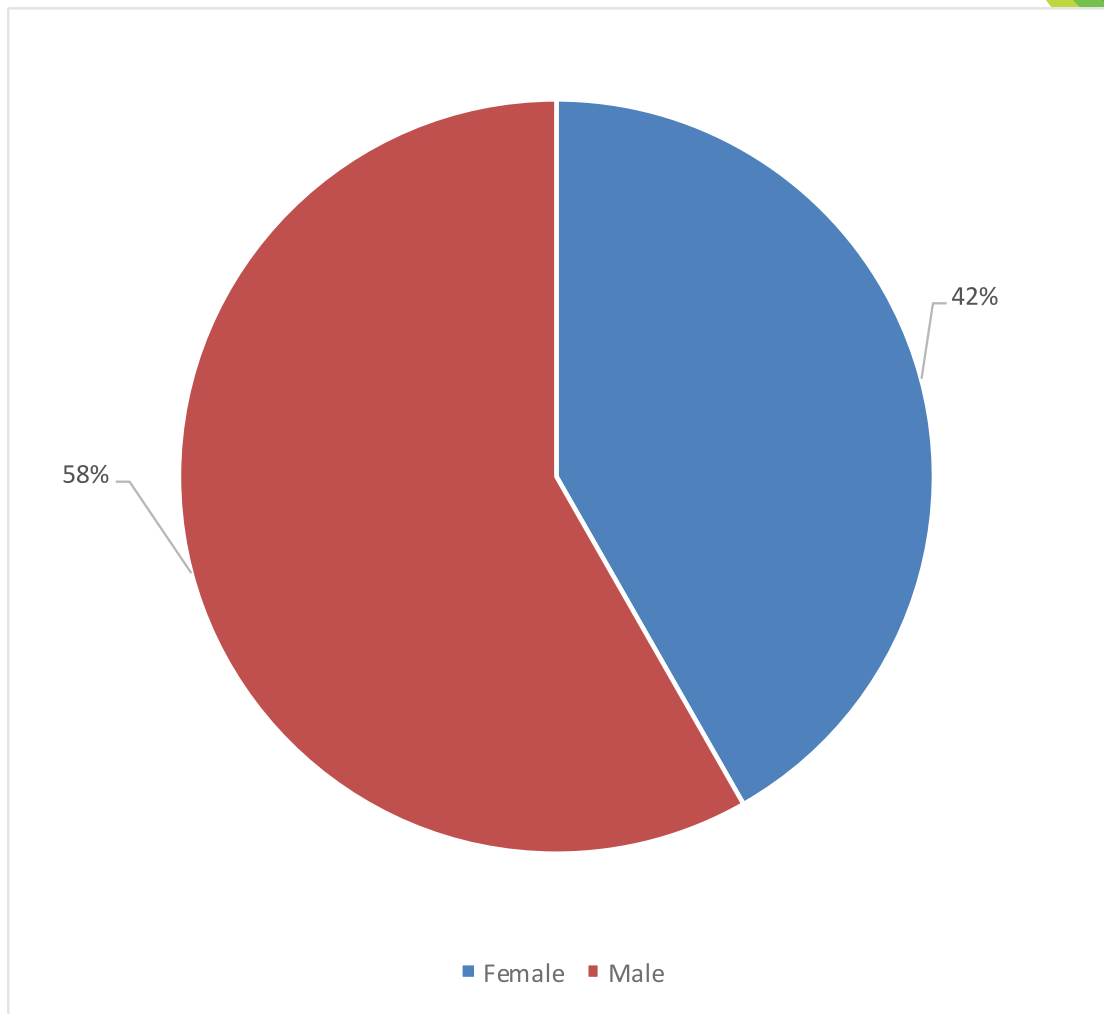


Graph.55. Number of students expressed in%

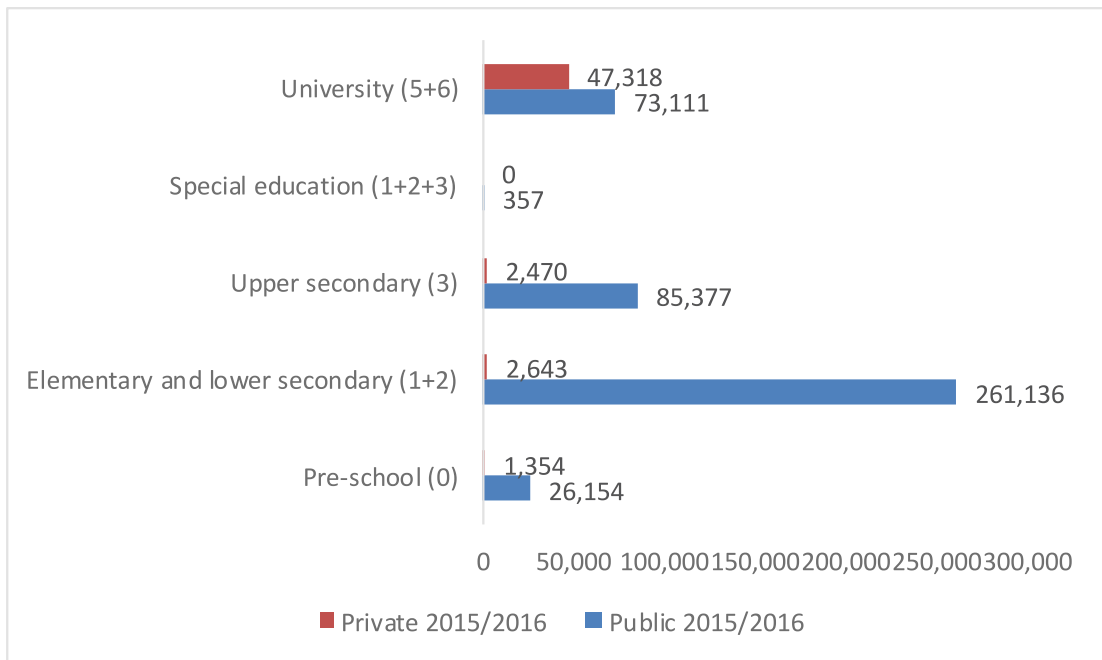
