1. Introduction

The publication: "Education Statistics in Kosovo 2025-2026" is the result of cooperation between the Ministry of Education, Science, Technology and Innovation (MESTI) and the Kosovo Agency of Statistics (KAS).

The source of data for pre-university education is the Education Management Information System (EMIS). Data on schools with instruction in Serbian language are not available, with the exception of the municipality of Kamenica (who report to the EMIS).

KAS provided the data on public and private university education.

1. 1. Description

The publication of "Education Statistics in Kosovo 2025-2026" contains data on:

- the number of children in preschool and pre-primary education by gender, nationality, age group and educational staff;
- the number of pupils in primary and lower secondary education by gender, nationality, grade and educational staff;
- the number of pupils in upper secondary education by gender, nationality, by vocational schools / gymnasiums and educational staff;
- the number of pupils in special education by gender, grade and by type of impairment-difficulty;
- the number of students in university education by gender, nationality, faculties-study programmes, study level (Bachelor and Master), the number of graduates at Bachelor and Master levels, academic staff, etc.

1.2. Definitions

Preschool education

The level of pre-school/pre-primary education is level 0 according to the ISCED (International Standard Classification of Education – ISCED 2011). This level is divided into two categories:

1. Level 01, which includes ages 0–2 years and is called Early Childhood Development;
2. Level 02, which includes ages 3–5, where age 3–4 is called preschool education, while age 5 is called pre-primary education.

Compulsory education

Compulsory education includes levels 1 and 2 according to the ISCED (International Standard Classification of Education – ISCED 2011). Primary education is classified as level 1 (grades 1–5), and lower secondary education is classified as level 2 (grades 6–9).

Compulsory education at the country level is organized in public and non-public educational-institutional institutions (licensed by the Ministry of Education).

The level of primary education

The level of primary education lasts 5 years, starting from the first to the fifth grade (grades 1–5).

Children who reach the age of 6 are enrolled at this level, while the age group of pupils at this level is from 6 to 10 years old.

The level of lower secondary education

The level of lower secondary education extends from grades six through nine (grades 6–9) and includes pupils in the age group 11–14 years.

The teaching process at this level is organized in public and non-public educational institutions (licensed by the Ministry of Education).

The level of upper secondary education

The level of upper secondary education is level 3 according to the ISCED (International Standard Classification of Education – ISCED 2011). The teaching process is organized in public and non-public educational institutions (licensed by the Ministry of Education).

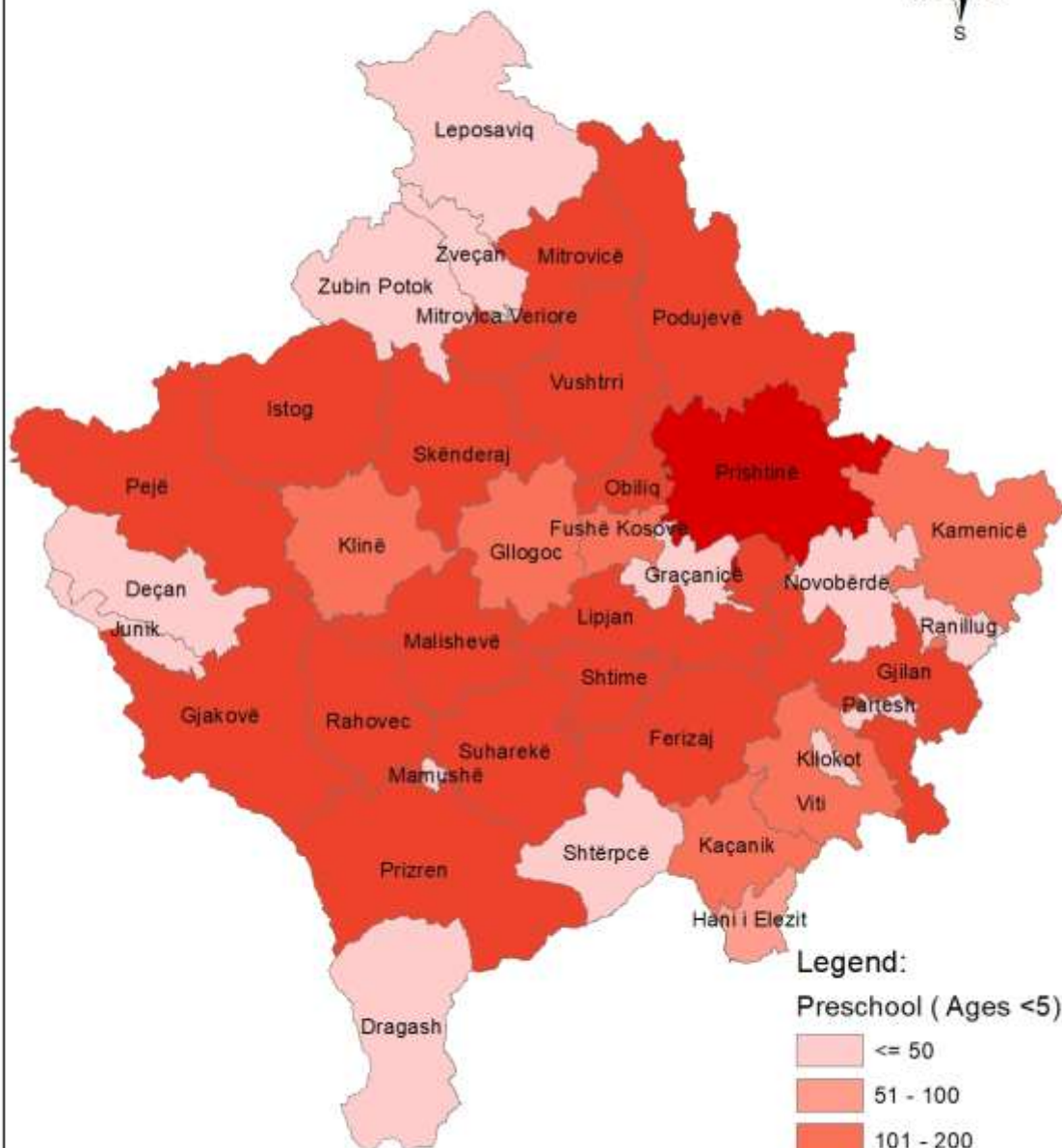
Based on the goals and content of the programme, these schools are organized in gymnasiums and vocational schools.

Upper secondary schools (gymnasiums and vocational schools) are profiled schools.

Gymnasiums are divided according to the following directions (or majors): social, general, natural sciences, mathematics-informatics and language.

Vocational schools are divided according to the directions: technical, agricultural, economic, medical, music, trade, theological, art, and centers of competence.

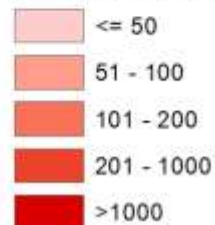
NUMBER OF CHILDREN IN PRESCHOOL EDUCATION ACCORDING TO MUNICIPALITY, 2025/2026

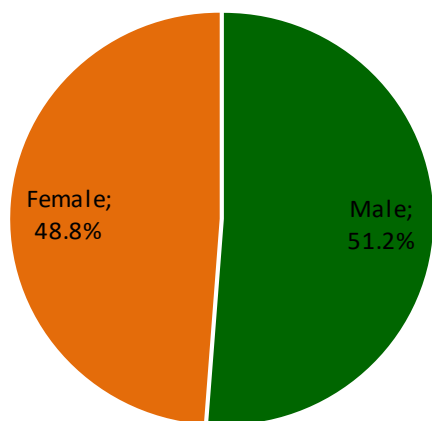

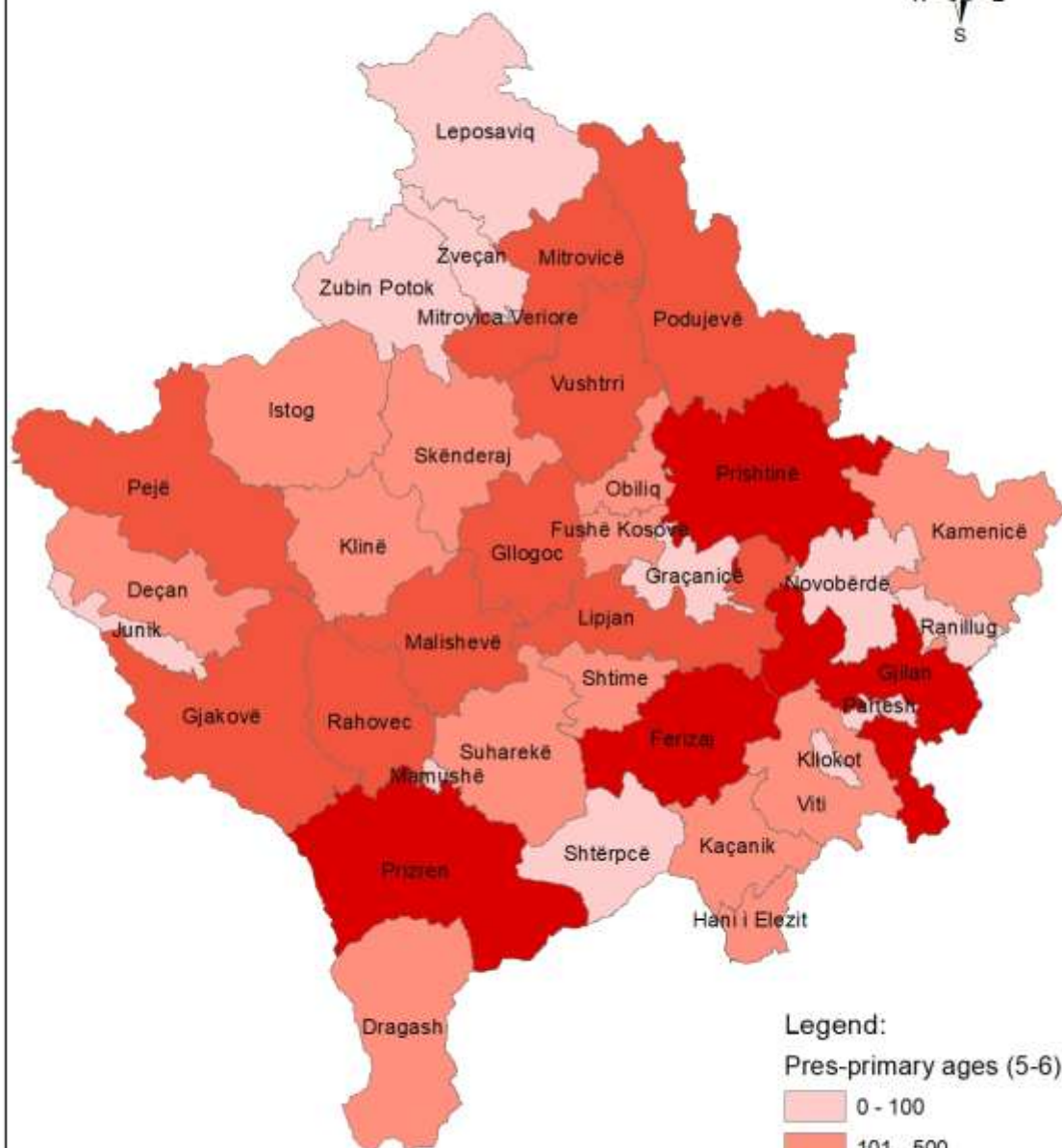

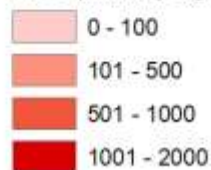
NUMBER OF CHILDREN PRELIMINARY EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY, 2025/2026

Pres-primary ages (5-6)

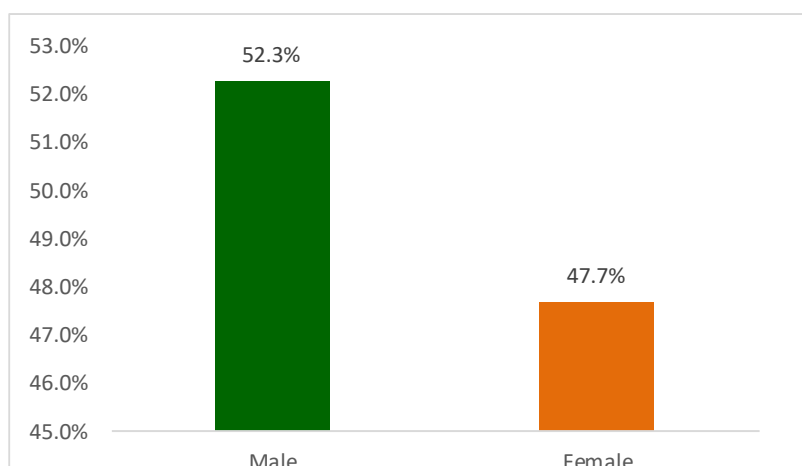

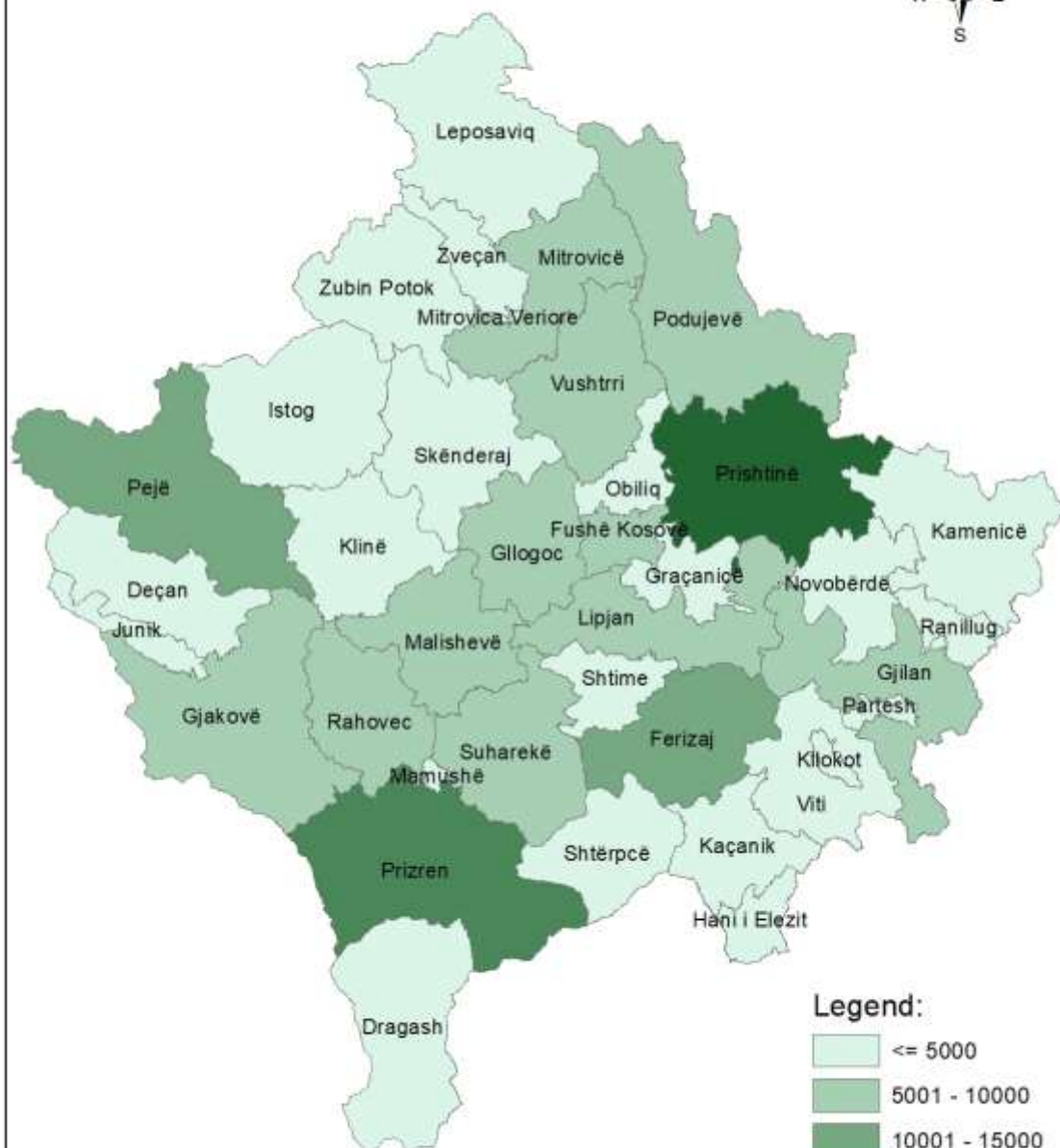

Graph 2. Gender structure in pre-primary education

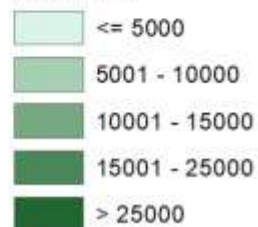

NUMBER OF PUPILS IN PRIMARY AND LOWER SECONDARY EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY, 2025/2026



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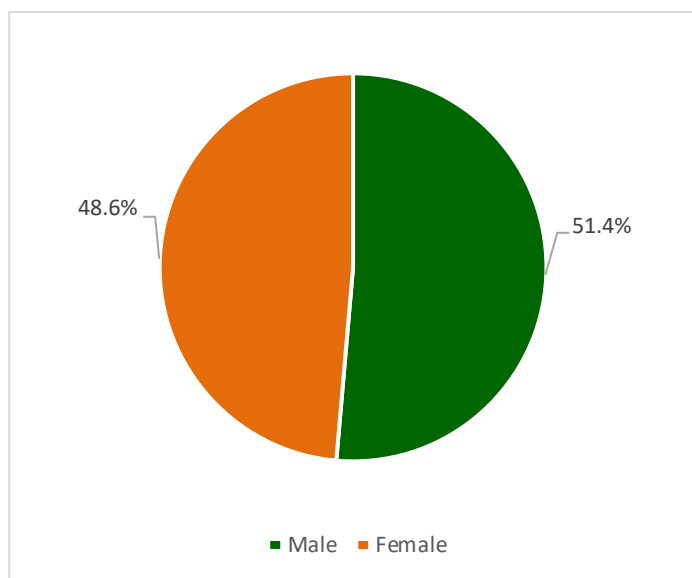

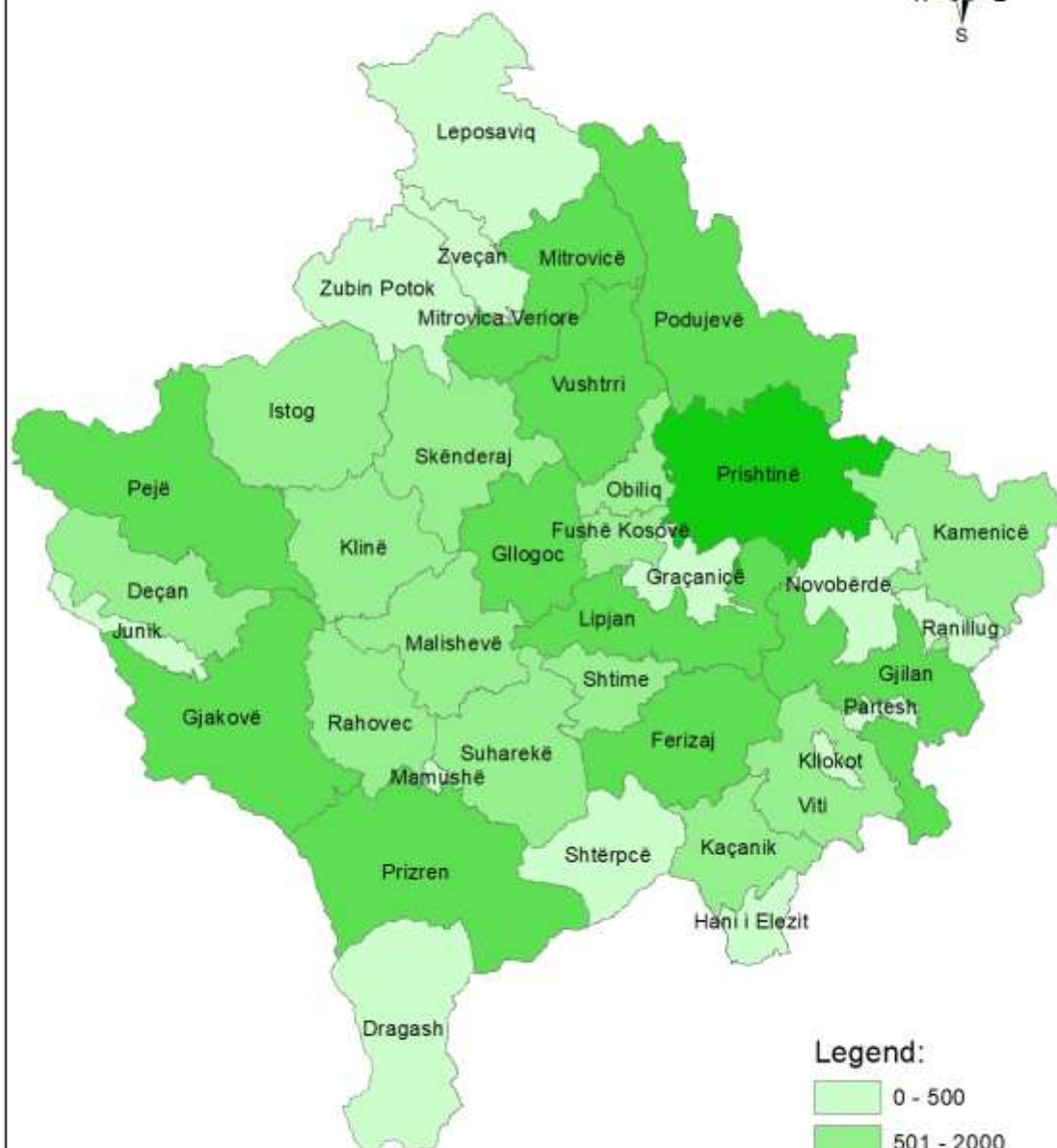

Graph 3. Gender structure in primary and lower secondary education

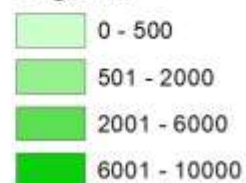

EDUCATION BY MUNICIPALITY, 2025/2026



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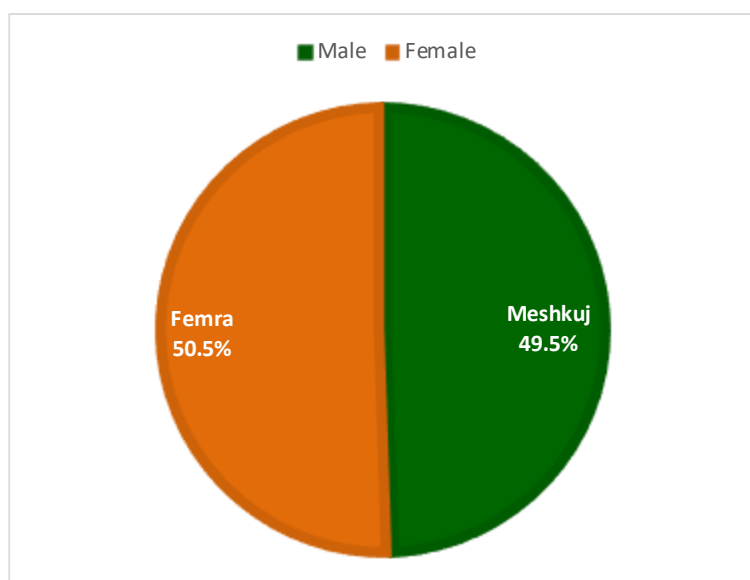

Graph 4. Gender structure in primary-upper secondary education

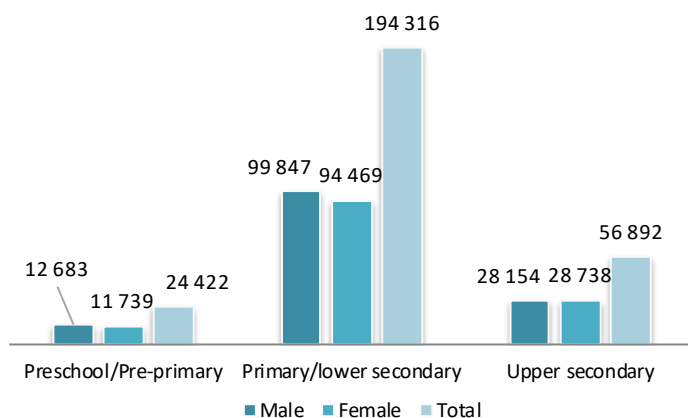
The gender structure in primary-upper secondary education presents a balance between the two genders, with 49.5% males and 50.5% females. This indicates equal gender representation and small differences between the two genders at this educational level.

The data shows that the largest number of pupils is in primary and lower secondary education (194,316 in total), which also accounts for the largest part of the inclusion in the education system. At this level, out of the total number, 99,847 are males and 94,469 are females.

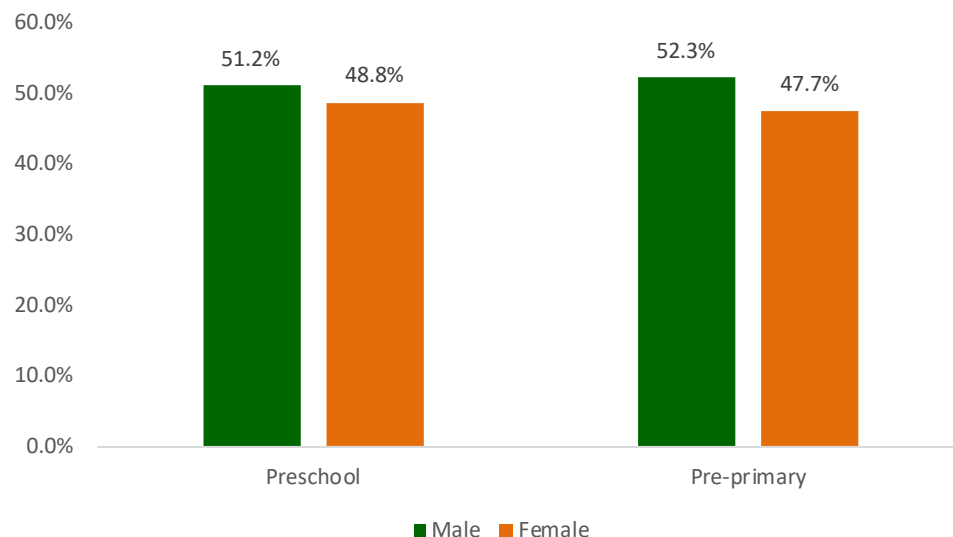
Upper secondary education has a total of 56,892 students, of whom 28,154 are males and 28,738 are females. While in preschool/pre-primary education there are 24,422 children, of whom 12,683 are males and 11,739 are females.

Regarding the gender structure, at all levels a good balance between males and females is observed, with very small differences in percentage. In general, the data show a stable distribution both by educational level and by gender.

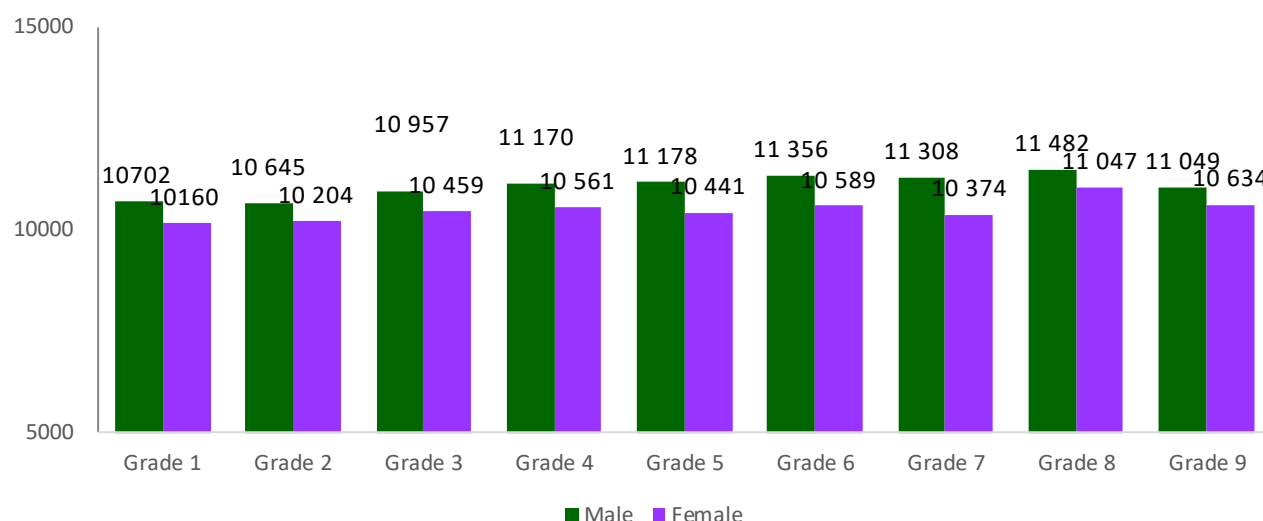
Graph 6. Number of children at preschool / pre-primary level by gender in %

The total number of children in the preschool and pre-primary levels is 24,422, of which 12,683 are males and 11,739 are females, accounting for 51.9% and 48.1% respectively. At the preschool level, males are 51.2% and females are 48.8%, while at the pre-primary level, males are 52.3% and females are 47.7%. The percentages show a small difference between the genders at both levels.

The graph shows the number of pupils in primary and lower secondary education by grade and gender. In general, the number of male pupils is slightly higher than that of female pupils in almost all grades, although the differences are relatively small.

In grade 1 there are 10,702 males and 10,160 females. In grade 2 there are 10,645 males and 10,204 females, while in grade 3 there are 10,957 males and 10,459 females. In grade 4 there are 11,170 males and 10,561 females, while in grade 5 there are 11,178 males and 10,441 females.

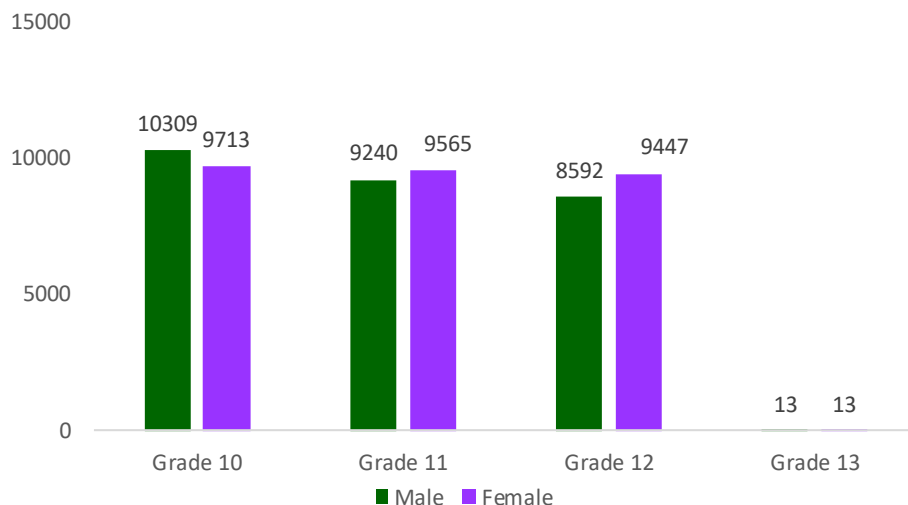
In the 6th grade there are 11,356 males and 10,589 females, while in the 7th grade there are 11,308 males and 10,374 females. The largest number of students is observed in the 8th grade, where there are 11,482 males and 11,047 females. In the 9th grade there are 11,049 males and 10,634 females.

In general, the distribution of pupils remains quite stable across all grades and the gender balance is relatively good throughout the primary and lower secondary education levels. The percentage analysis shows that the gender distribution remains balanced across all grades, with males accounting for around 51–52%, while females for around 48–49% of the total number of pupils.

The graph shows the number of pupils in upper secondary education by grade and gender. In all main grades (10–13) a relatively good gender balance is observed, with a similar percentage of male and female pupils.

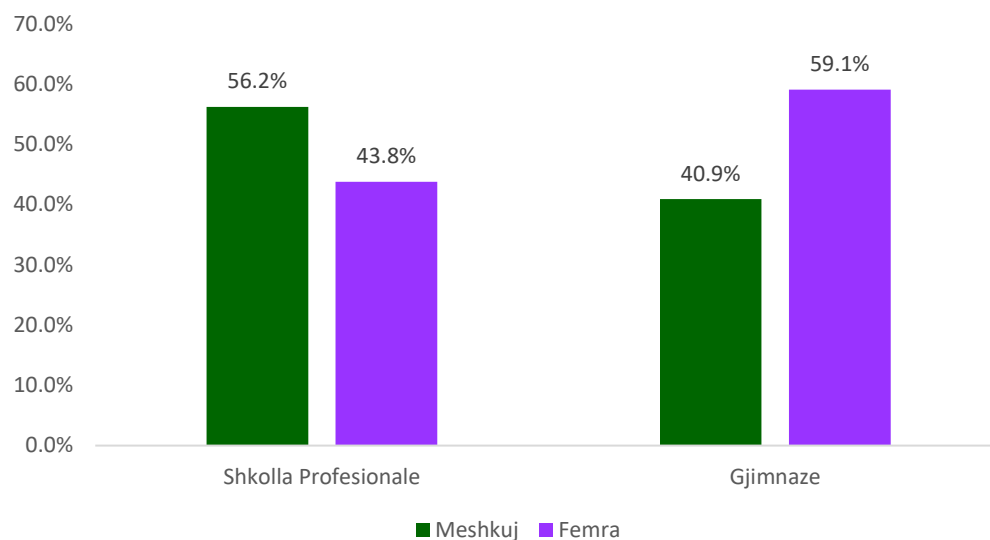
In the 10th grade there are a total of 20,022 pupils, of whom 10,309 are male and 9,713 are female. In the 11th grade there are 18,805 pupils, of whom 9,240 are male and 9,565 are female. In the 12th grade there are a total of 18,039 pupils, of whom 8,592 are male and 9,447 are female.

Overall, the data show that in upper secondary education there is a fairly balanced gender distribution in most grades.

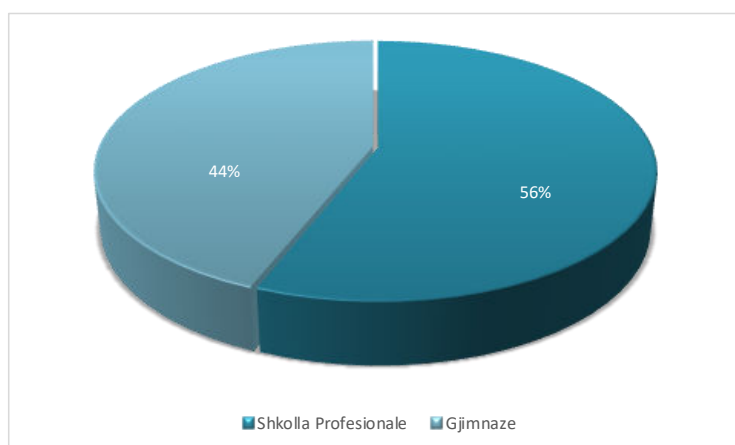

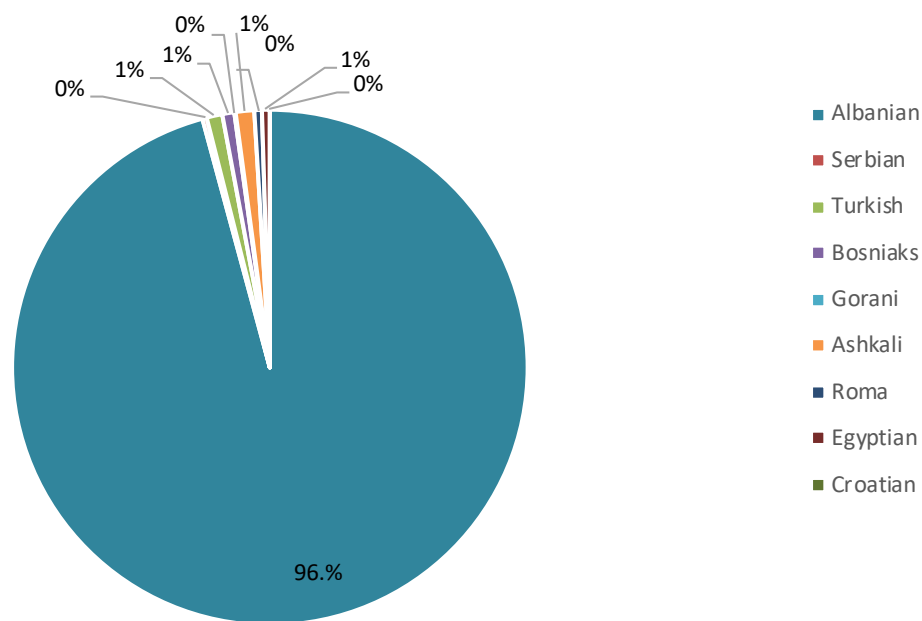

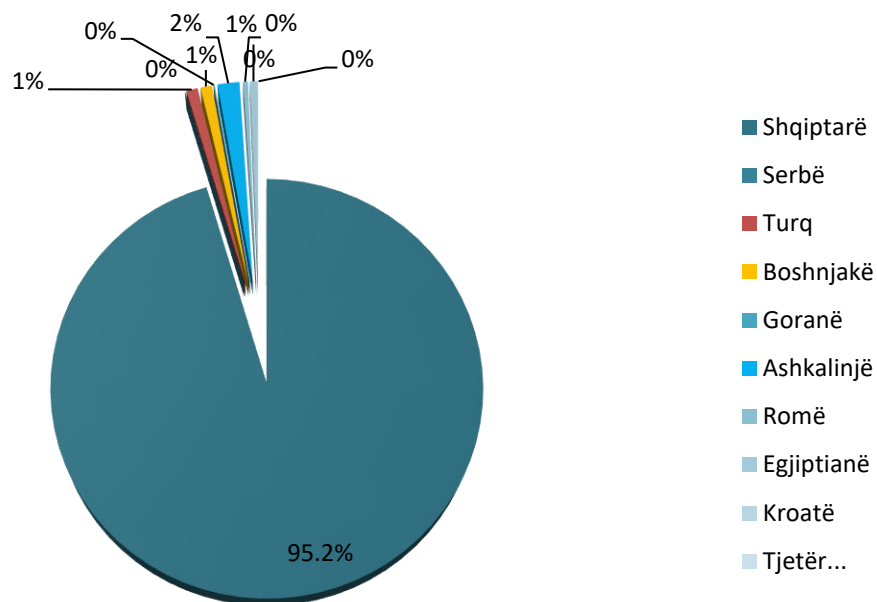
Graph 9. Number of children in pre-primary education by ethnicity in %

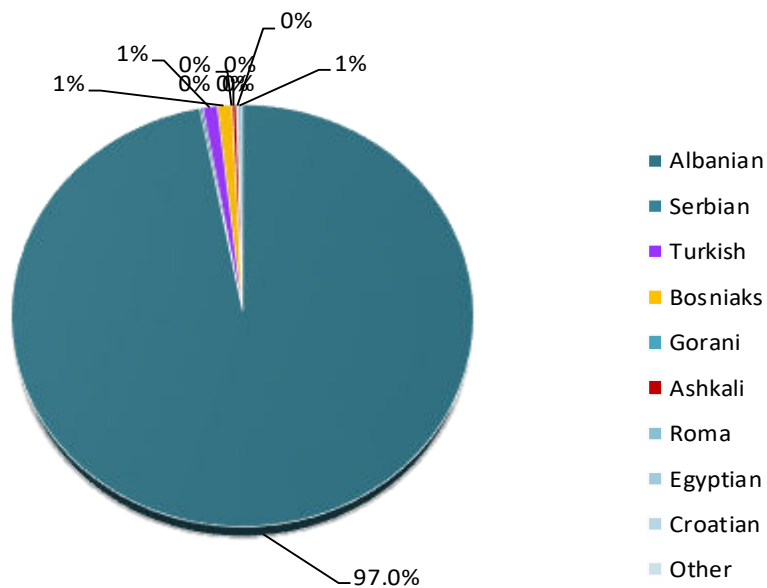
Graph 10. Number of pupils in primary and lower secondary education by ethnicity in%

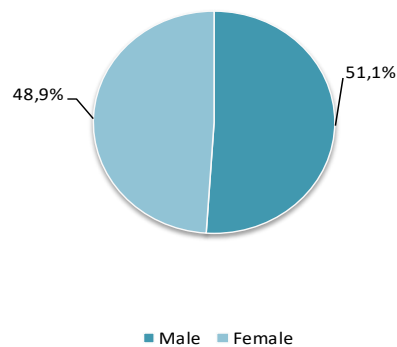
Graph 11. The number of pupils in upper secondary education by ethnicity in%

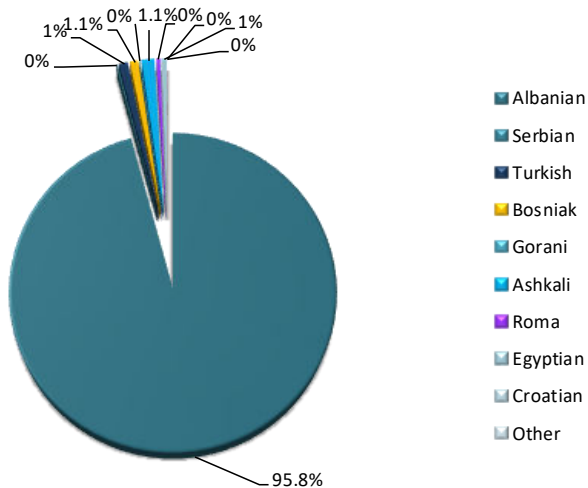
Graph 12. Gender structure in pre-university education in%

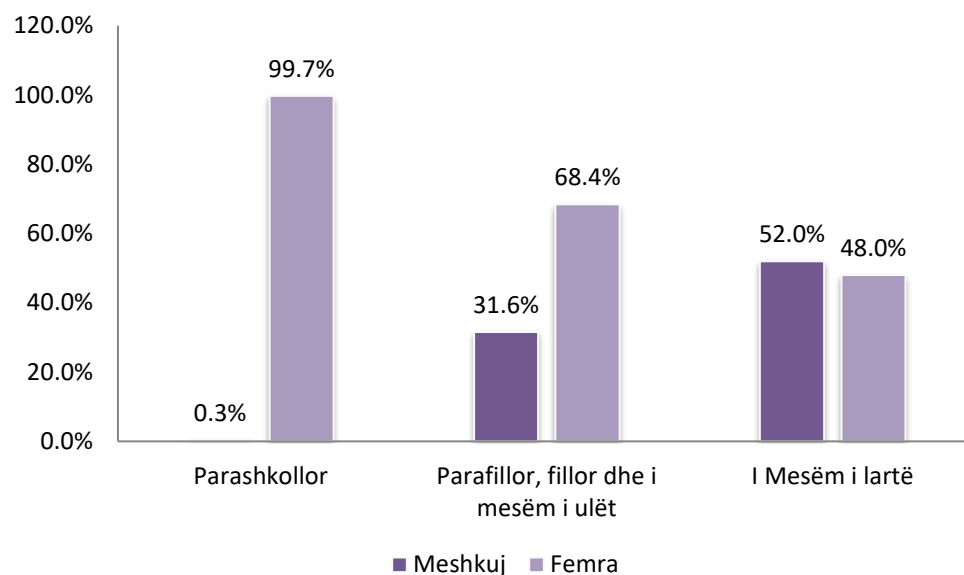

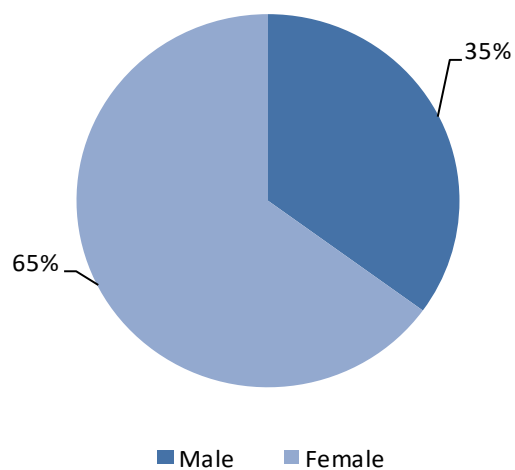
Graph. 1. Teachers by level in%

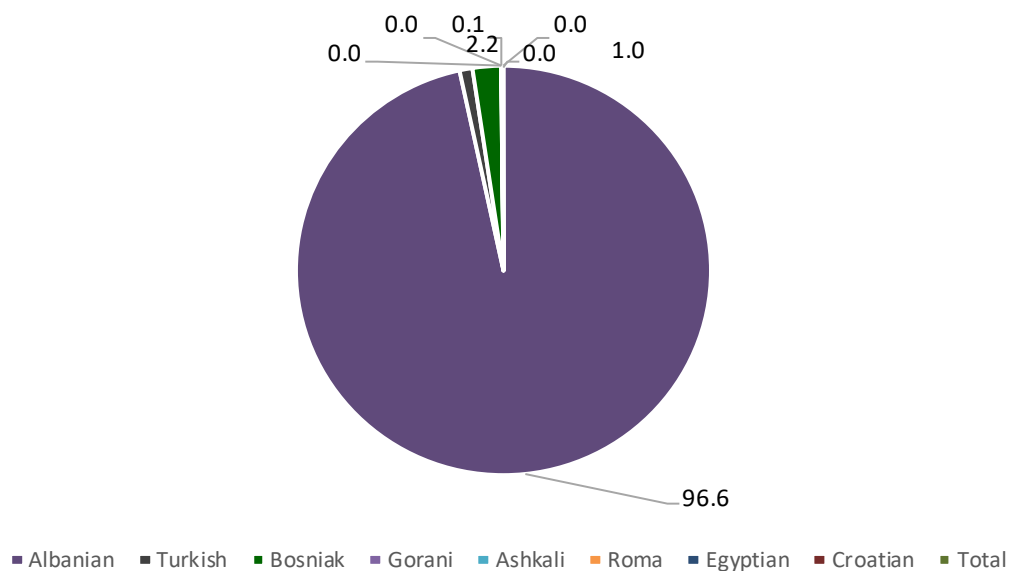
Graph. 2. Teachers by gender in%

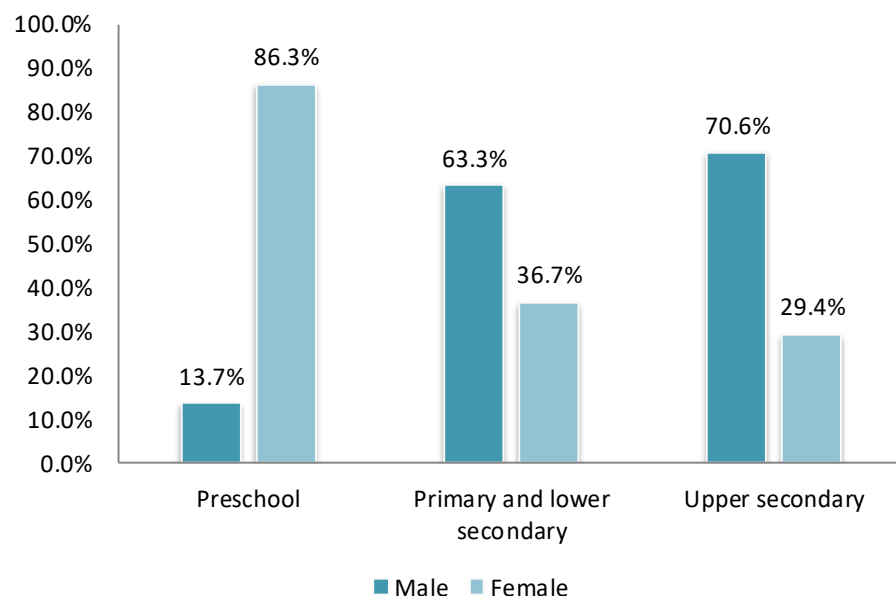
Graph. 3. Teachers by ethnicity in%

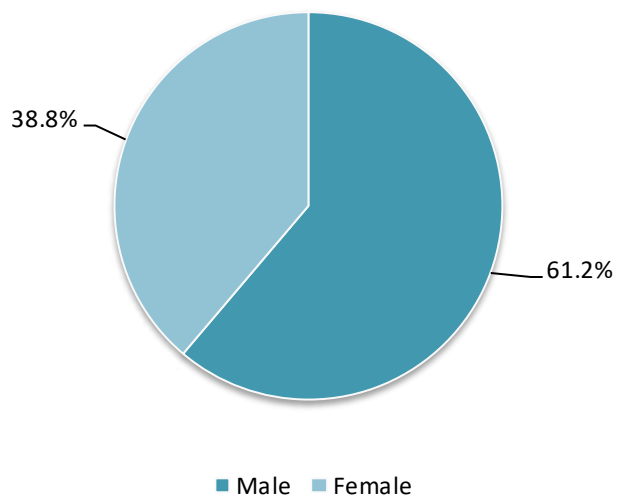
Graph. 4. Administrative personnel by gender for levels, in%

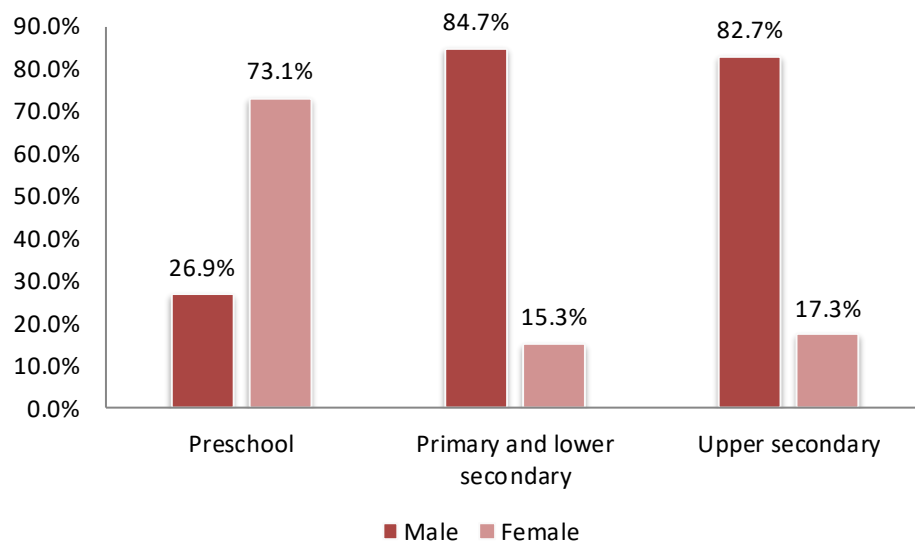
Graph 14. Administrative personnel by gender in%

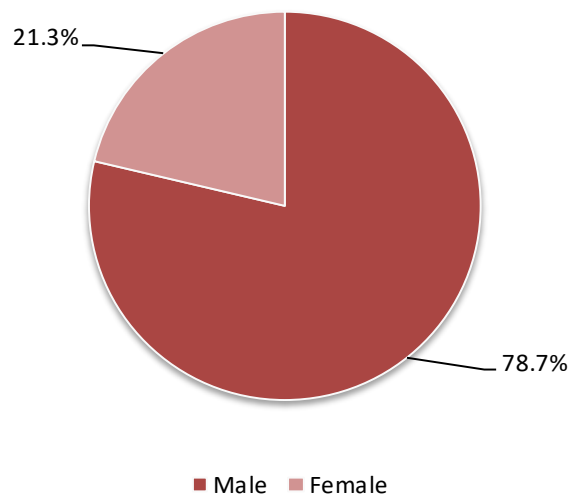
Graph. 21. Support personnel by level in%

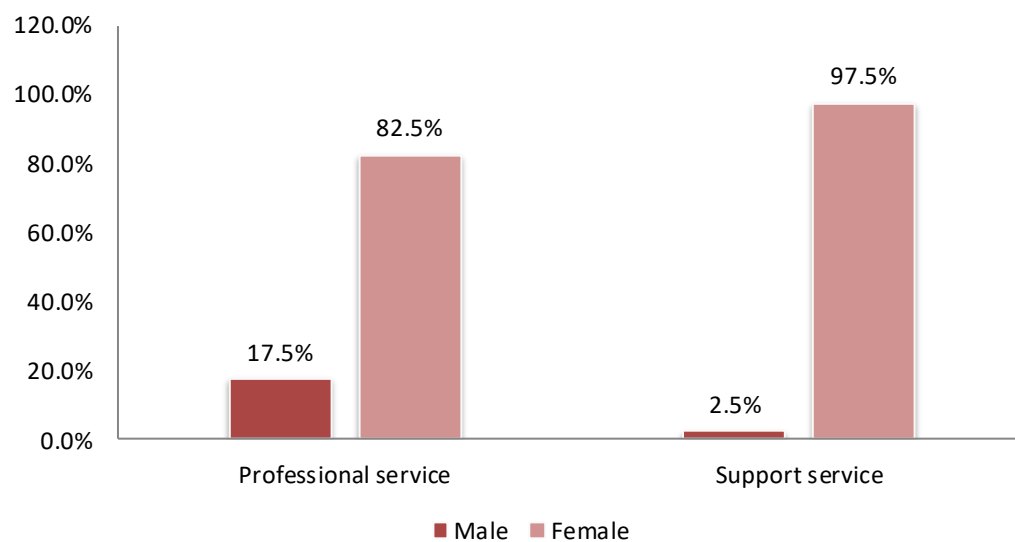
Graph. 5 Support personnel by gender in%

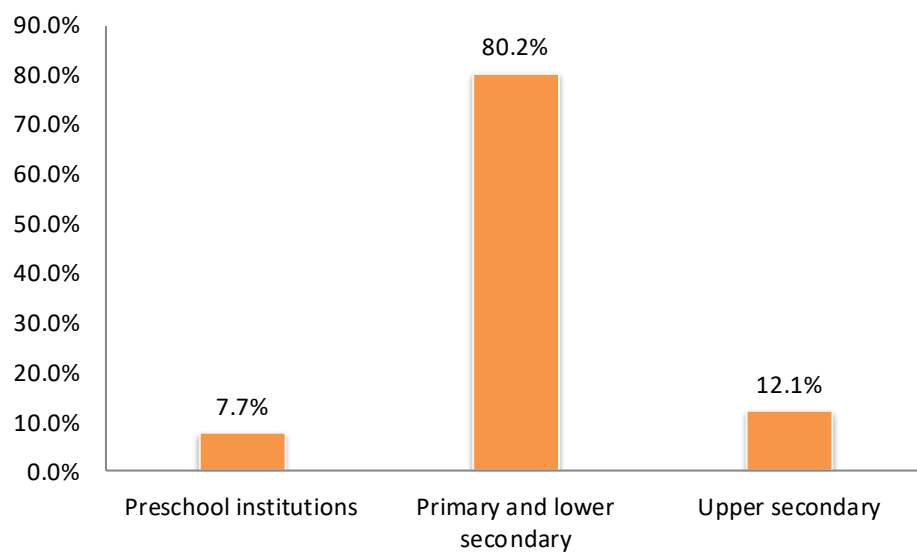

Graph 16. Educational institutions by level

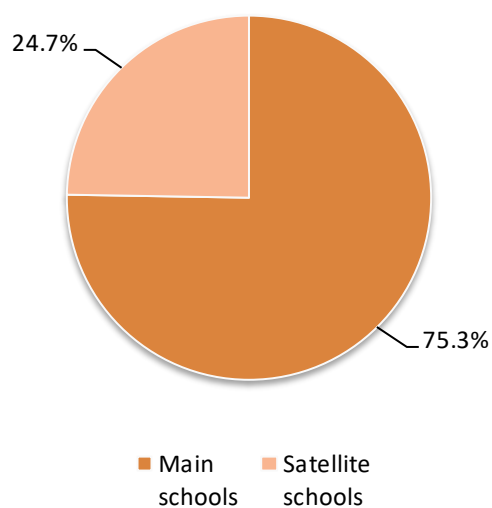

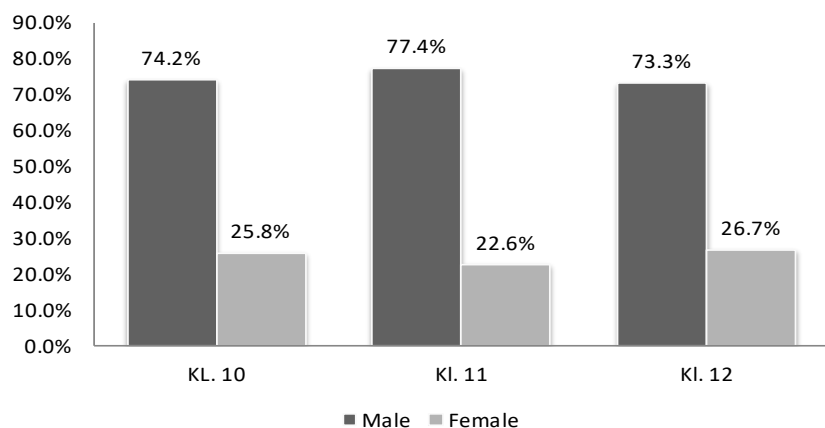

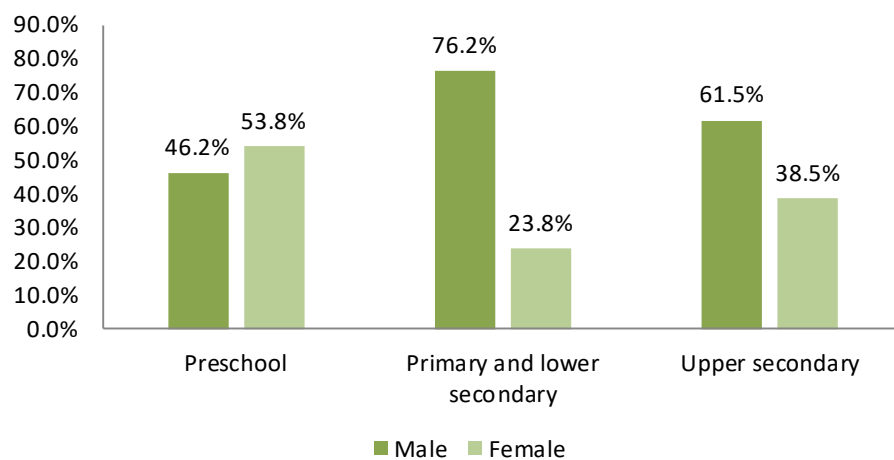

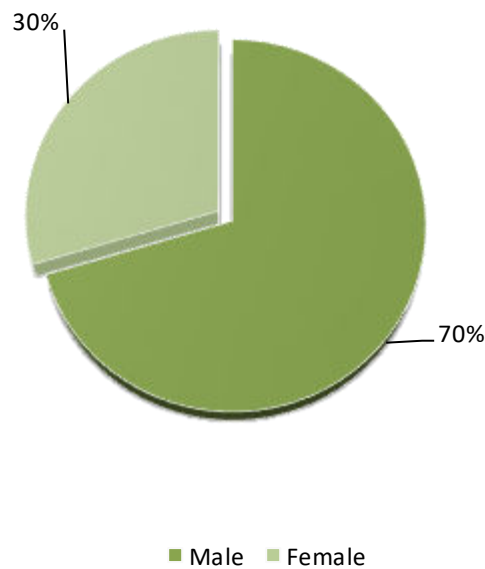

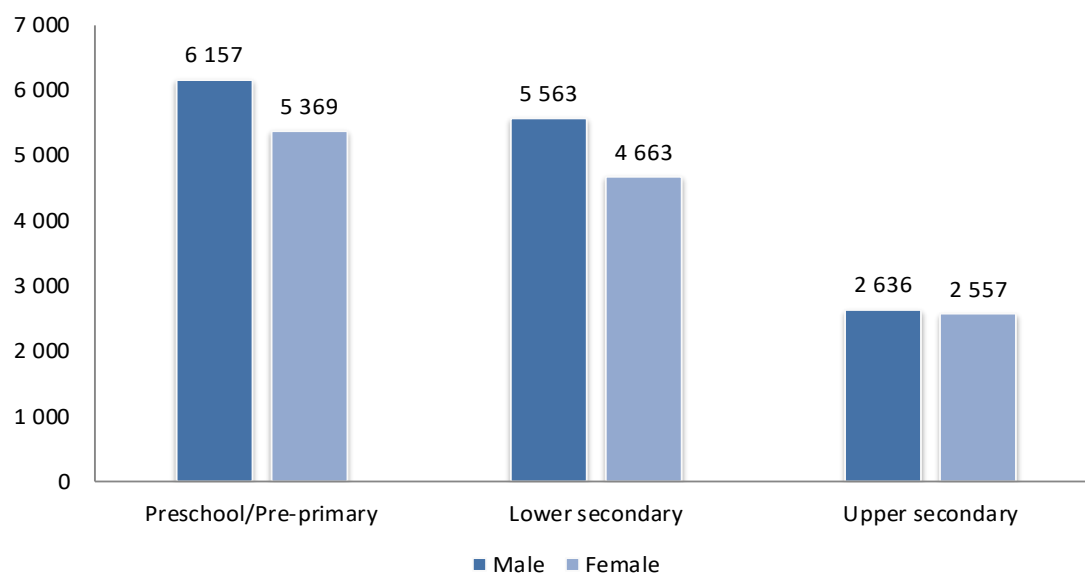

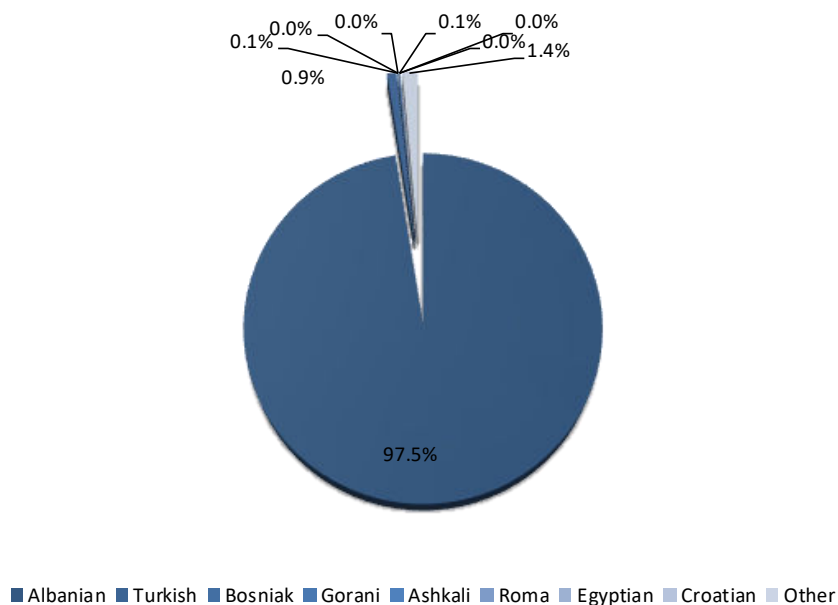
Graph 21. Number of children / pupils in private education by level

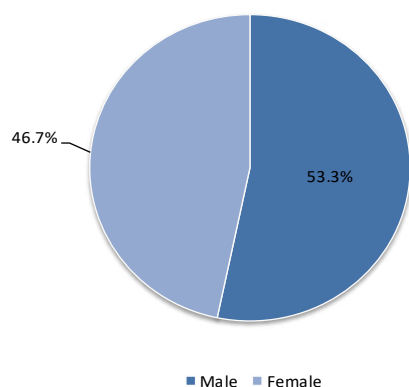
Graph 22. Number of children/pupils by ethnicity in private pre-university education

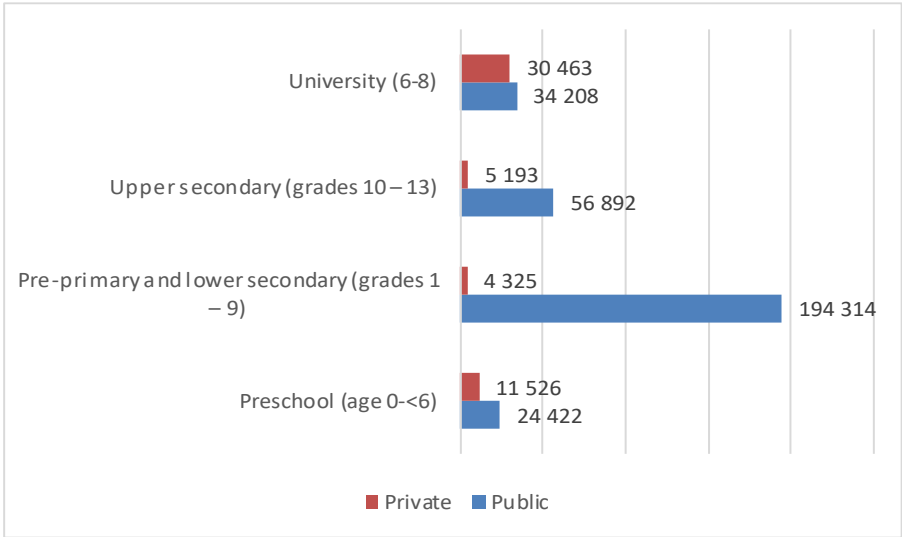
